

COVIDSafe Events

The Australian Water Association has closely followed Government recommendations to develop COVIDSafe Guidelines for AWA events going forward. These guidelines have been developed to ensure attendee health and safety at AWA events.

Venue



Venue set up will follow the relevant State or Territory Government guidelines i.e. square metre spacing per attendee and maximum capacities strictly adhered to.

Physical Distancing



Physical distancing measures will be in place for all meetings and events including floor markers in potential areas of congestion.

Registration



Contactless registration options have been implemented to avoid congestion.

Catering



We will work closely with venue partners to ensure best practice in food preparation is observed and options with minimal contact are provided.

Hygiene Practices



Enhanced hygiene practices will include hand sanitiser in key areas, extra cleaning of key touchpoints, microphone and USB restrictions, and signage prompts.

Paperless Events



Our events will be paperless, so we recommend downloading the AWA Event App or downloading our digital programs prior to arriving at an event.

Trained Staff



AWA Staff have been trained to deliver a COVIDSafe event and will be available onsite to respond to any concerns.

Sustainability



All implemented COVIDSafe measures have been driven with sustainability in mind.
