

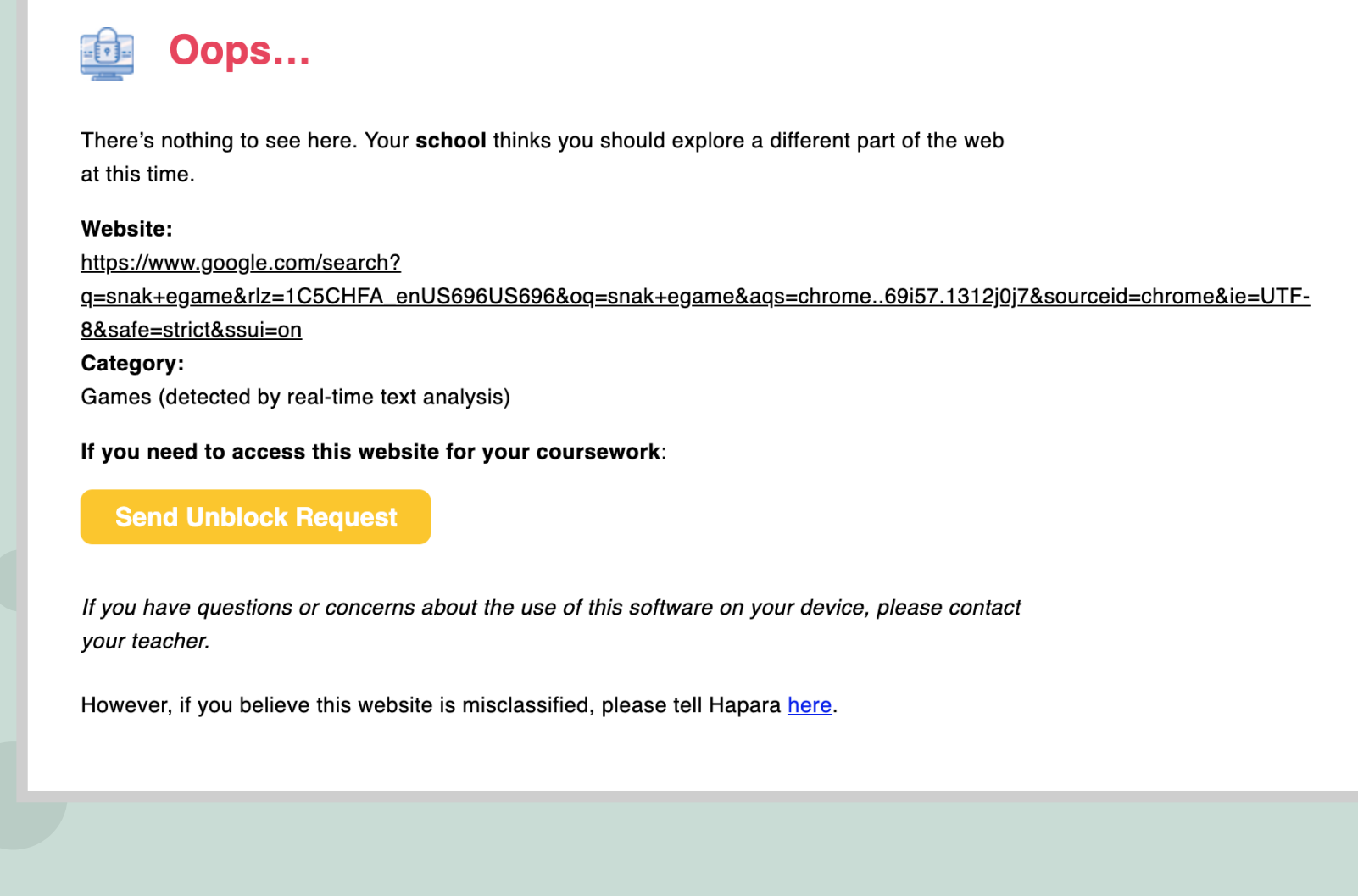
Checklist for amplifying teacher and student voice in district technology decisions



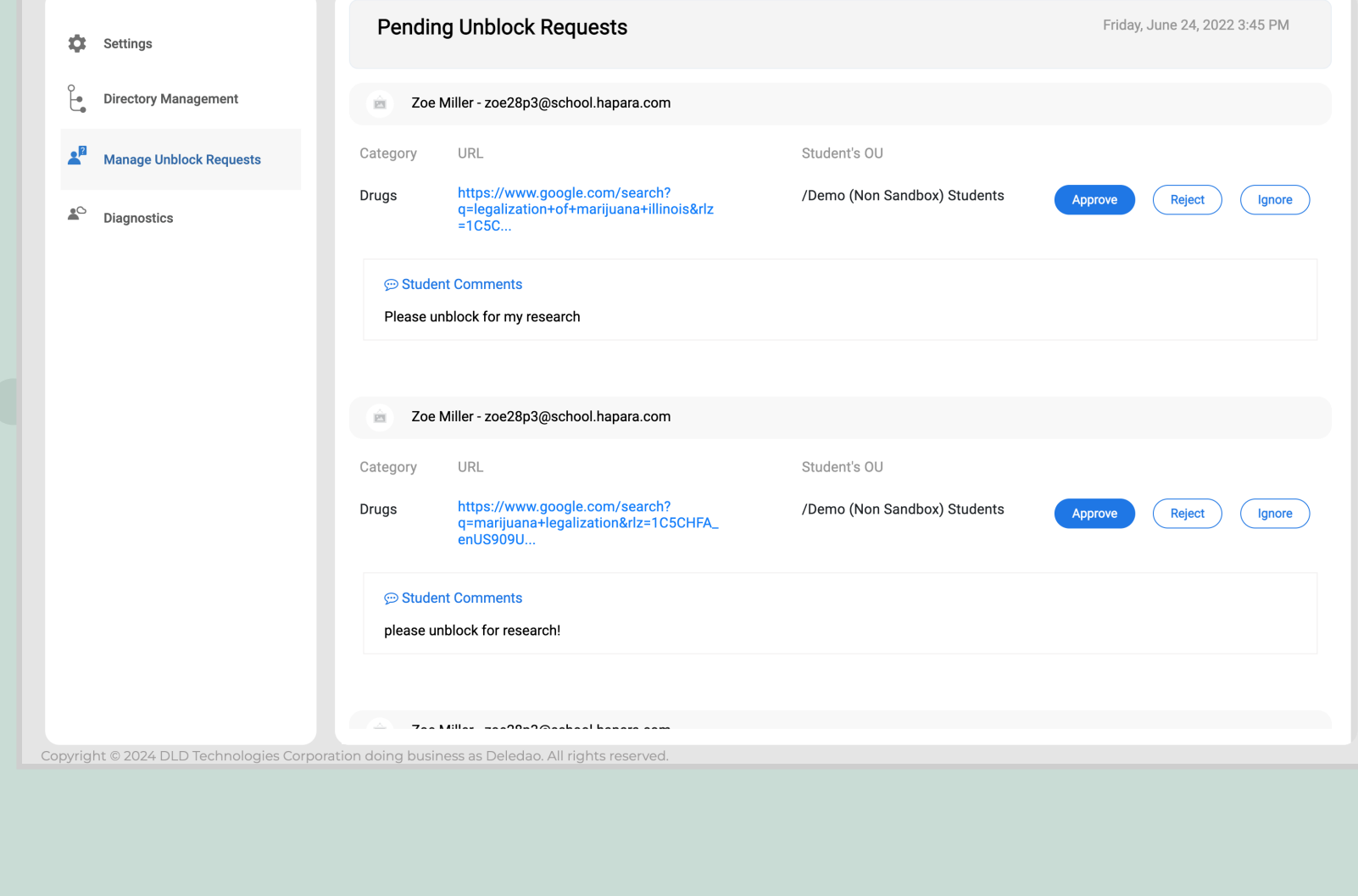
Review this simple checklist to ensure your school's digital tools are amplifying teacher and student voice.



Does the digital tool allow for input from teachers and students when it comes to decisions that affect learning?



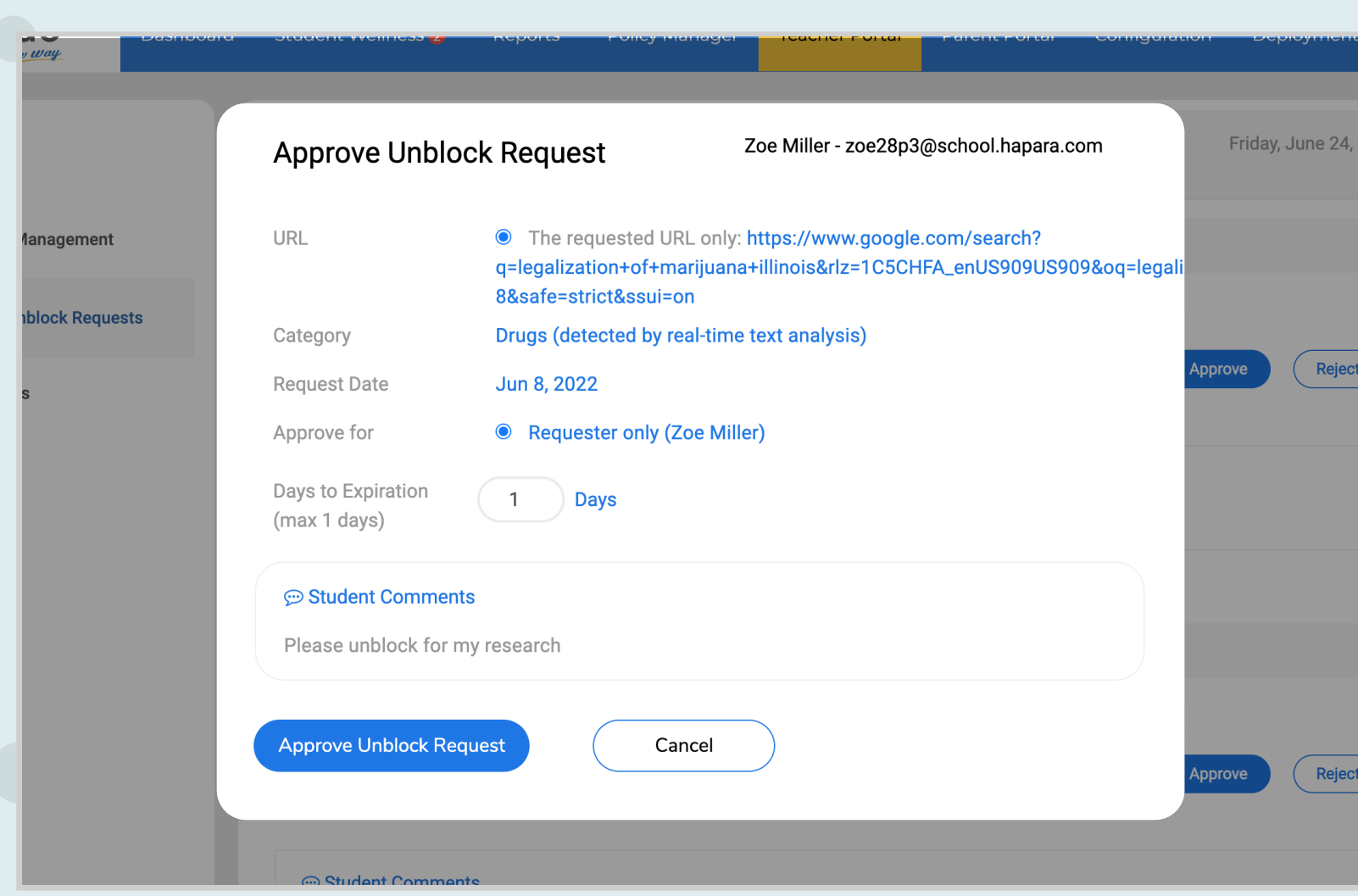
Deledao ActiveScan, presented by Häpara **amplifies learner voice** by allowing them to challenge a blocked website needed for learning. The learner can submit a website for review with an explanation of why access to the site is needed. The teacher can approve or reject the site and even has the ability to determine the scope of the filtering and an expiration date.



Once a learner submits a website for review, the teacher **can approve or reject the site** and even has the ability to determine the scope of the filtering and an expiration date.



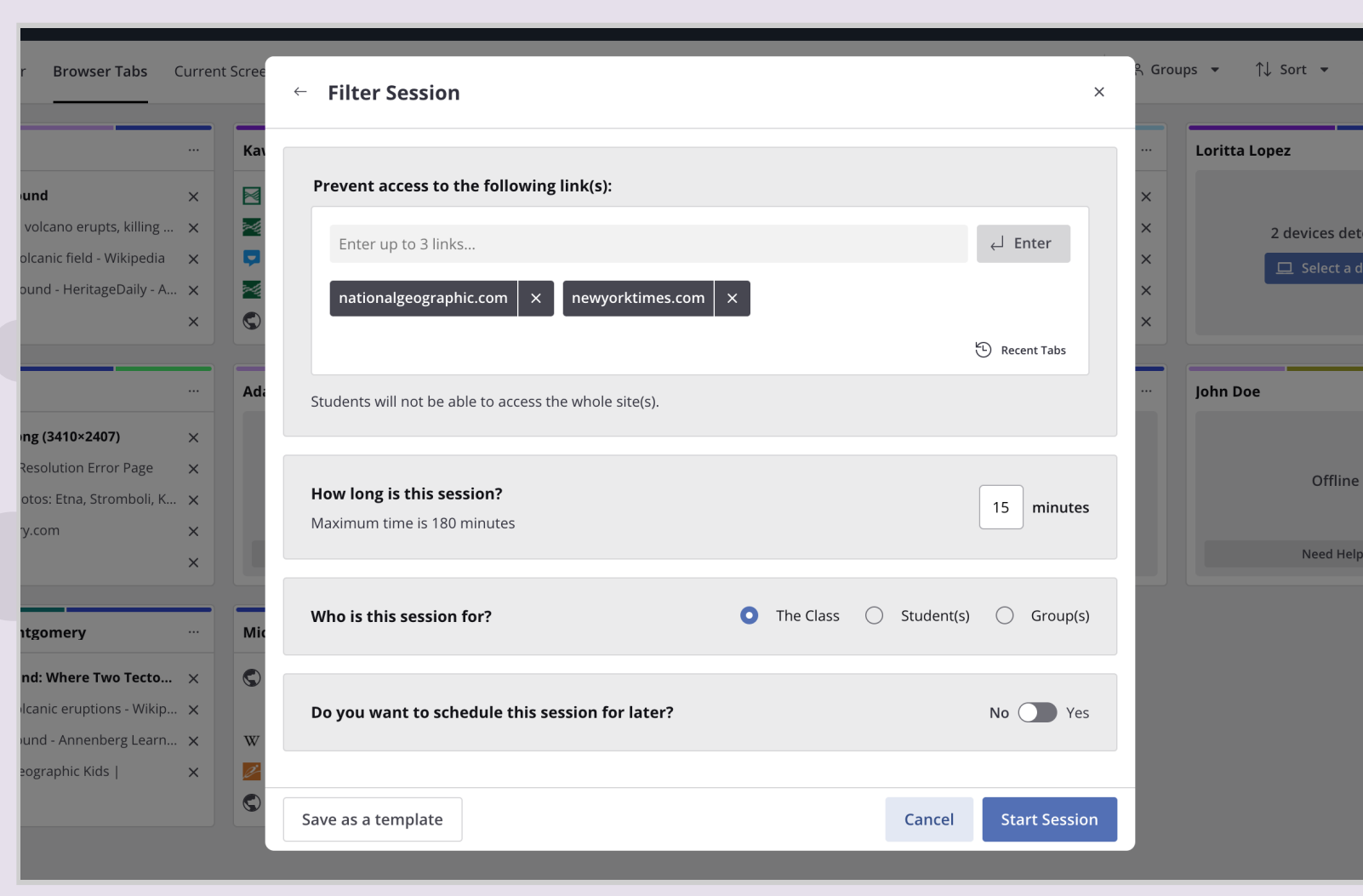
Are teachers able to manage learning decisions for digital tools without relying on school technology personnel?



In the Deledao ActiveScan, presented by Häpara teacher portal, if teachers approve a student unblock request, the teacher **can even set the expiration date**. Once the specified time has elapsed, the standard filter restrictions will be re-enabled.



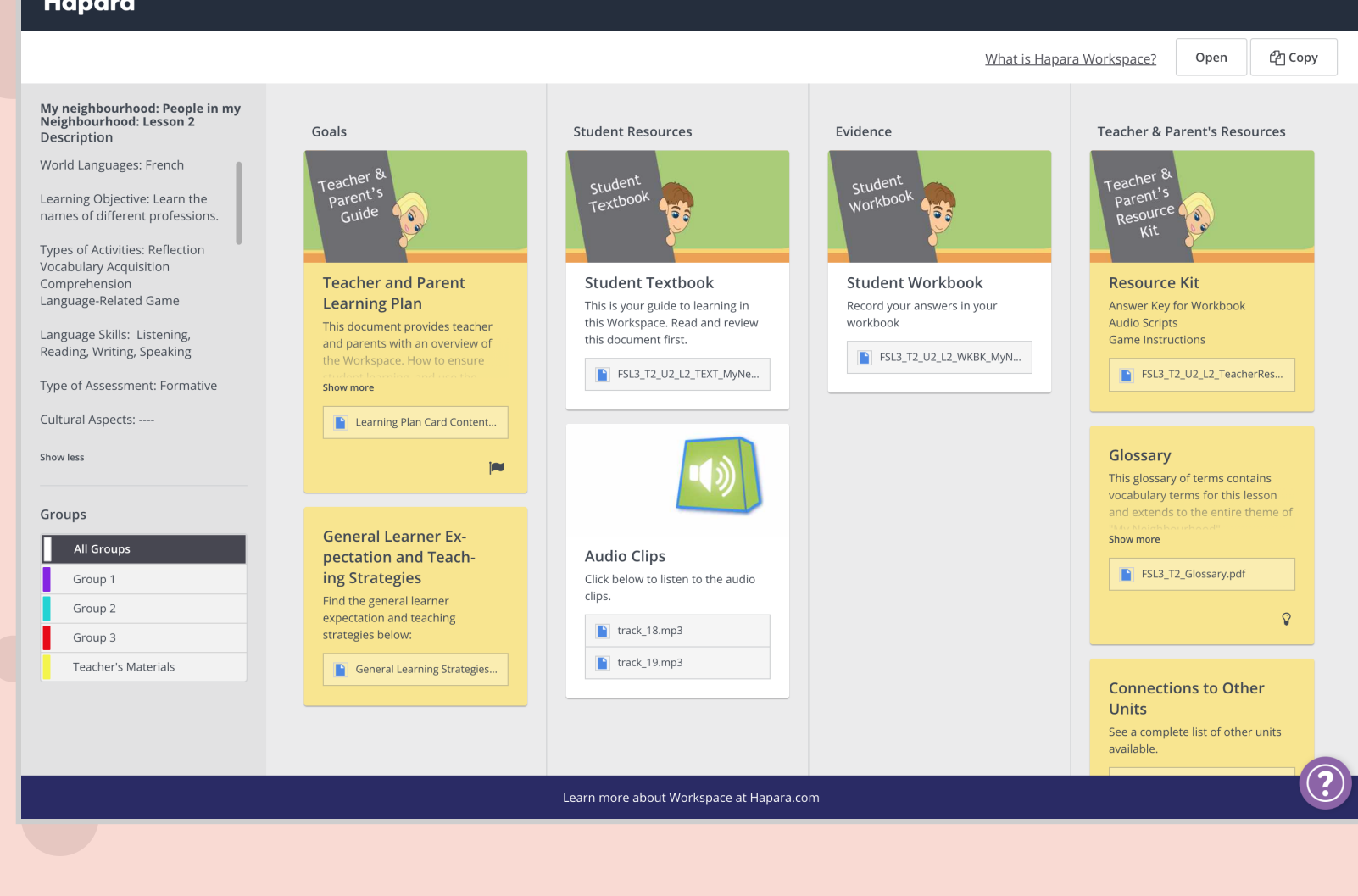
Do teachers have the ability to continue instruction without relying on school technology personnel?



In Häpara Highlights, if a teacher encounters a website that should be blocked, the teacher can set up a "filter session" to block that website for the remaining class time. No instructional time wasted!



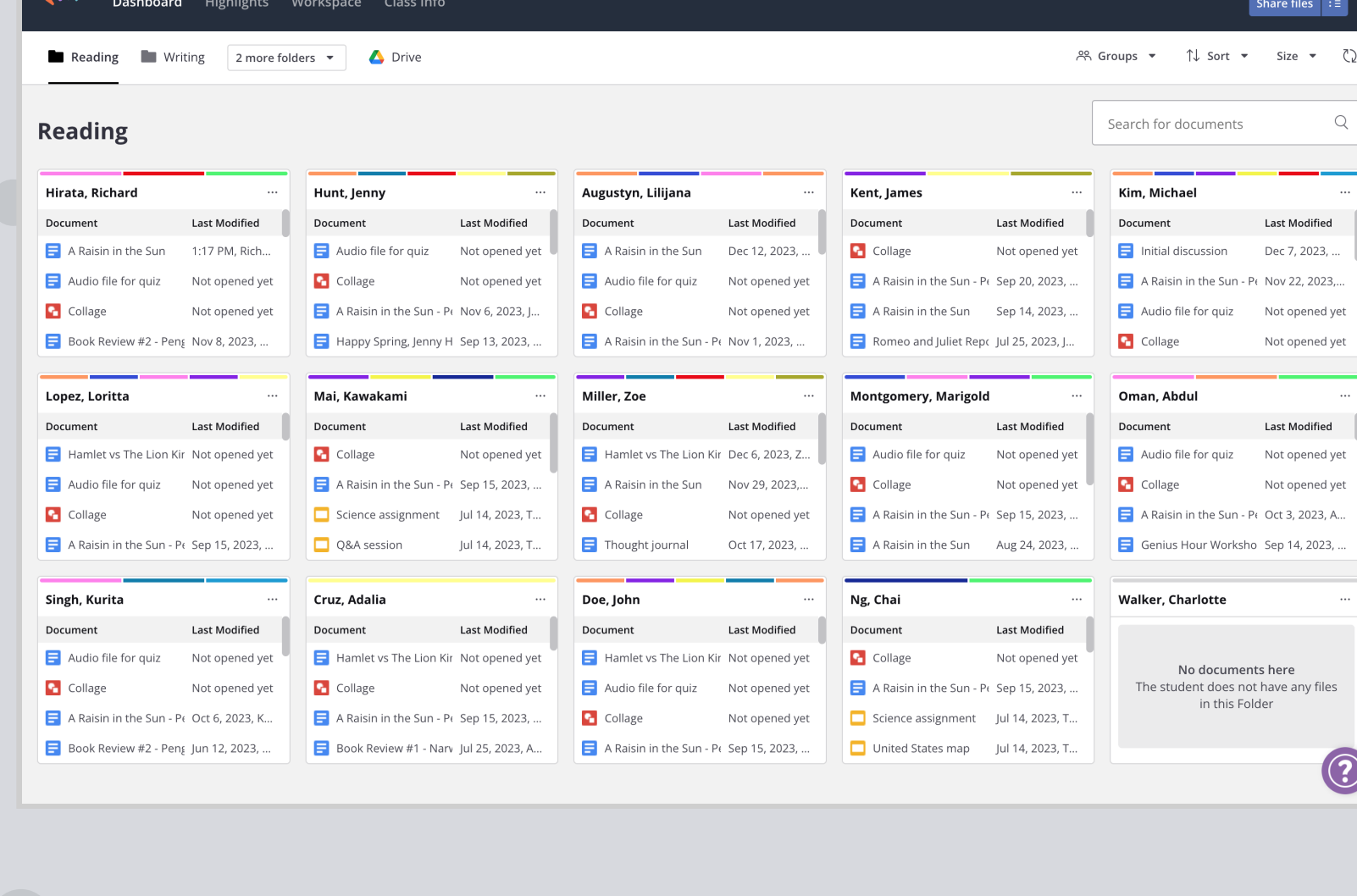
Can teachers use the digital tool to easily create learning materials?

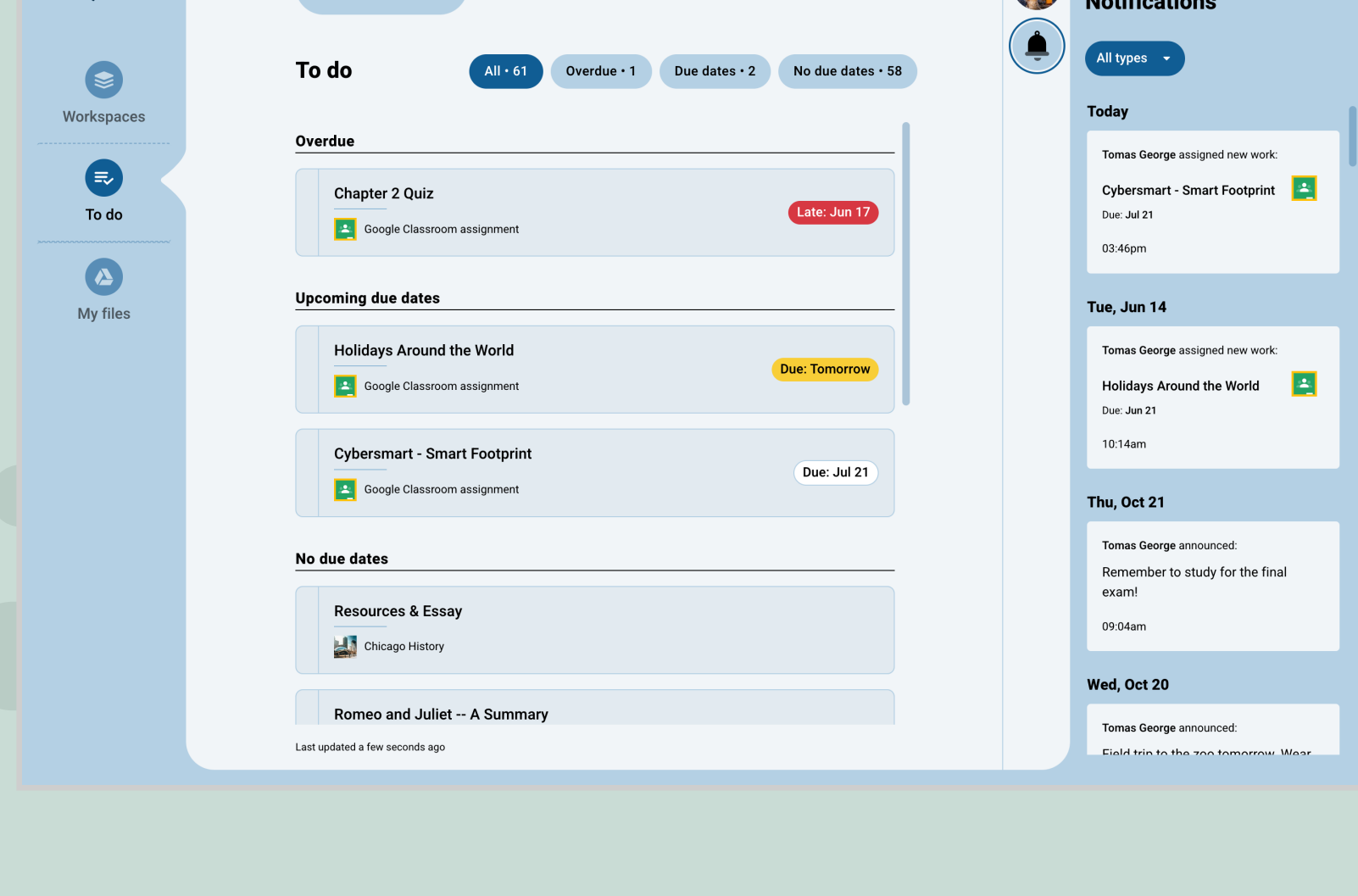
Can teachers use the digital tool to provide quick feedback to learners?



Häpara's Teacher Dashboard provides teachers with access to all student work in Google Drive making it easy to quickly share formative feedback during the learning process.



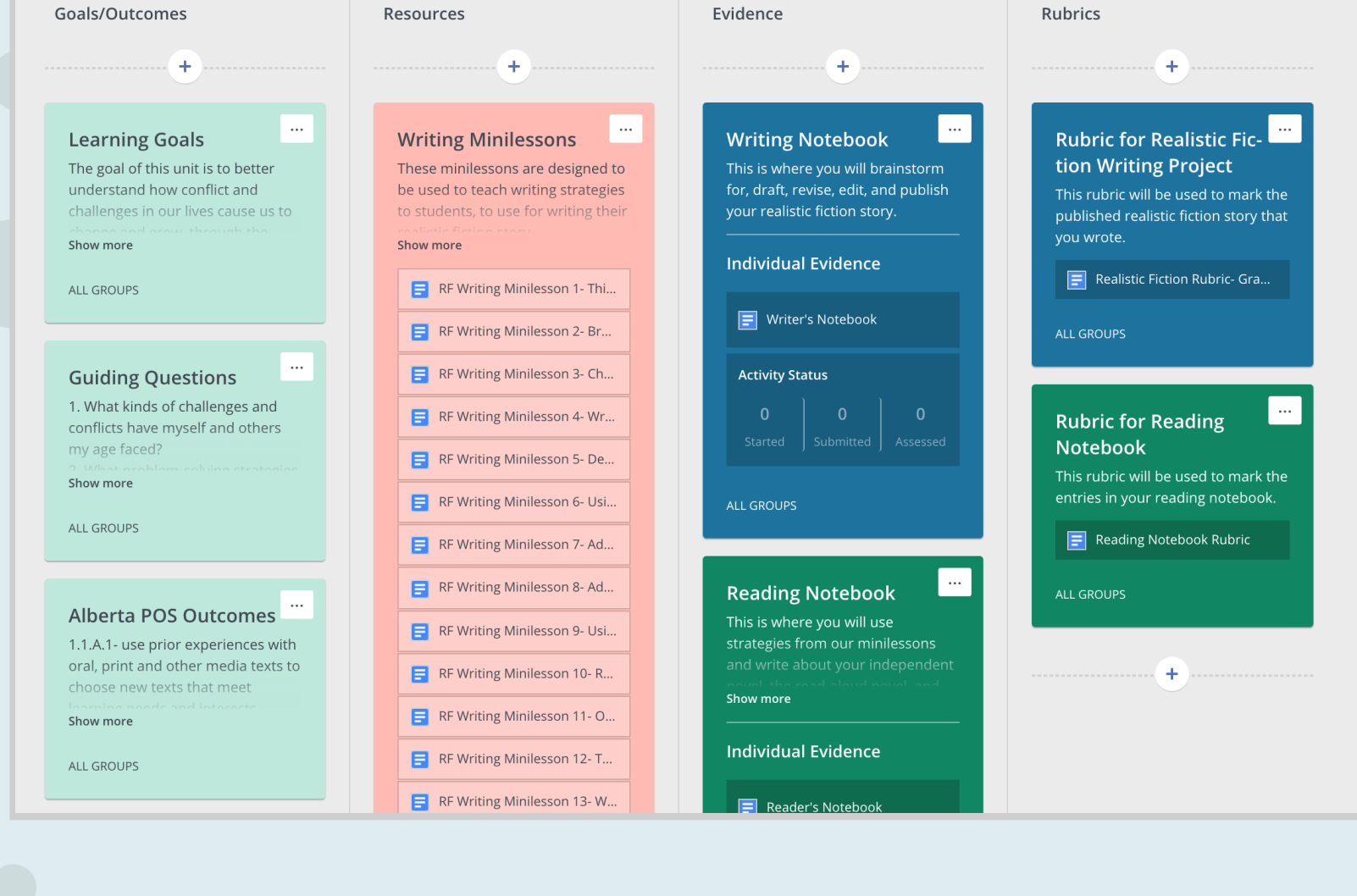
Can students access learning materials from multiple devices?



What can halt learning in its tracks? Access issues. Häpara's Student Dashboard is a device agnostic tool that provides access to all learning materials in one convenient location.



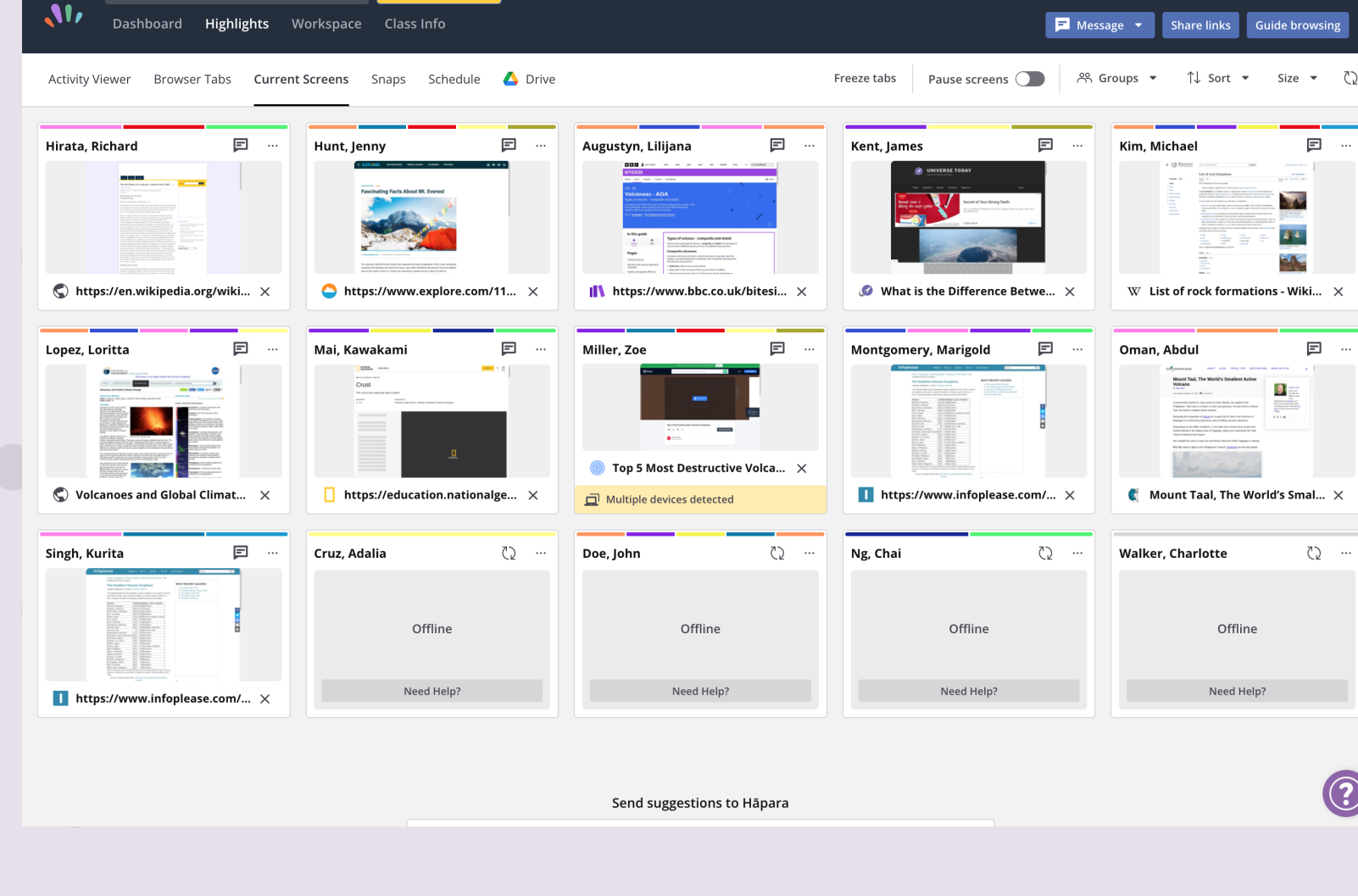
Do technologies encourage learning agency and empower student learning?



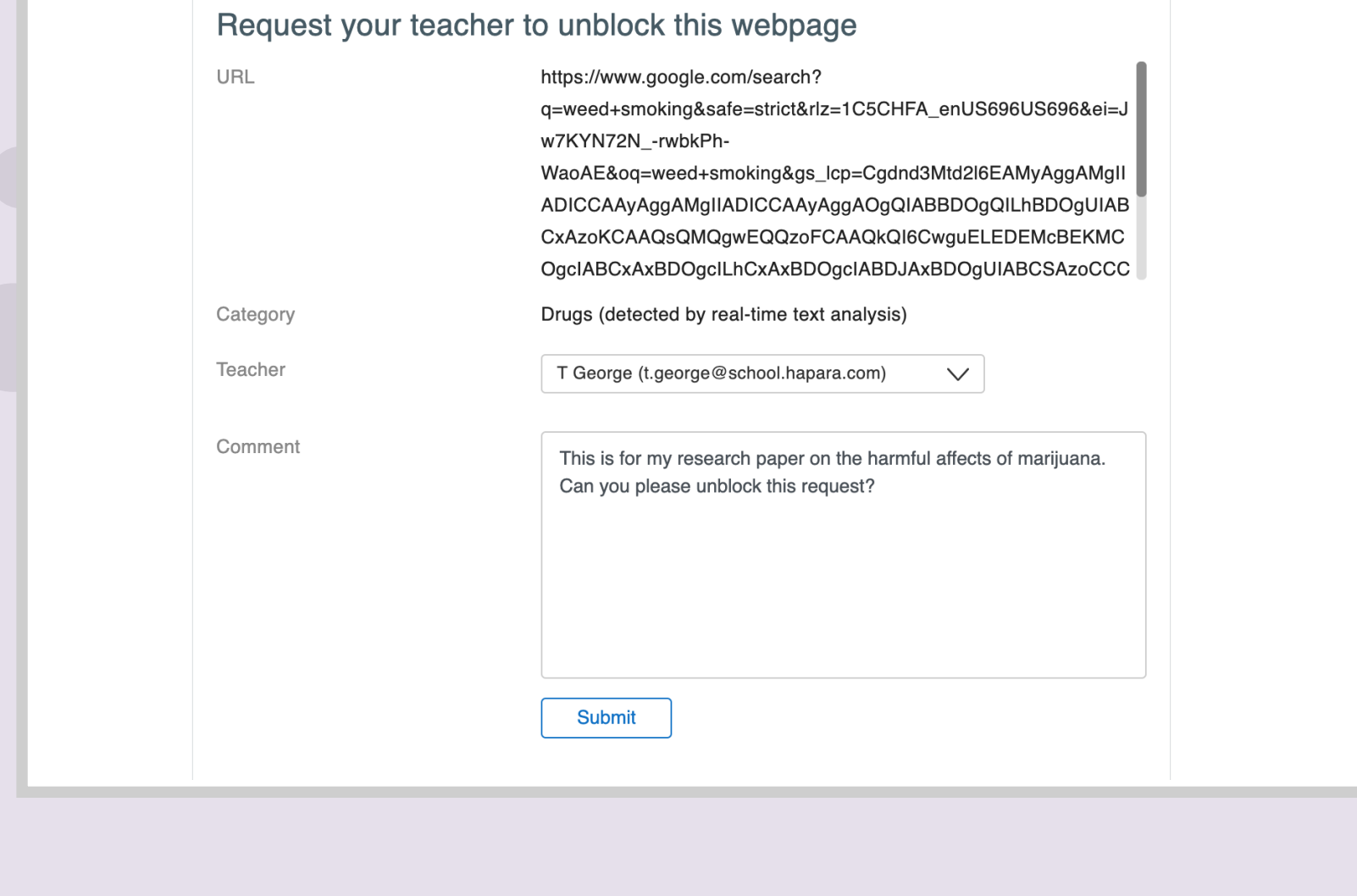

Are students empowered to learn how to use the internet responsibly, while ensuring safety?



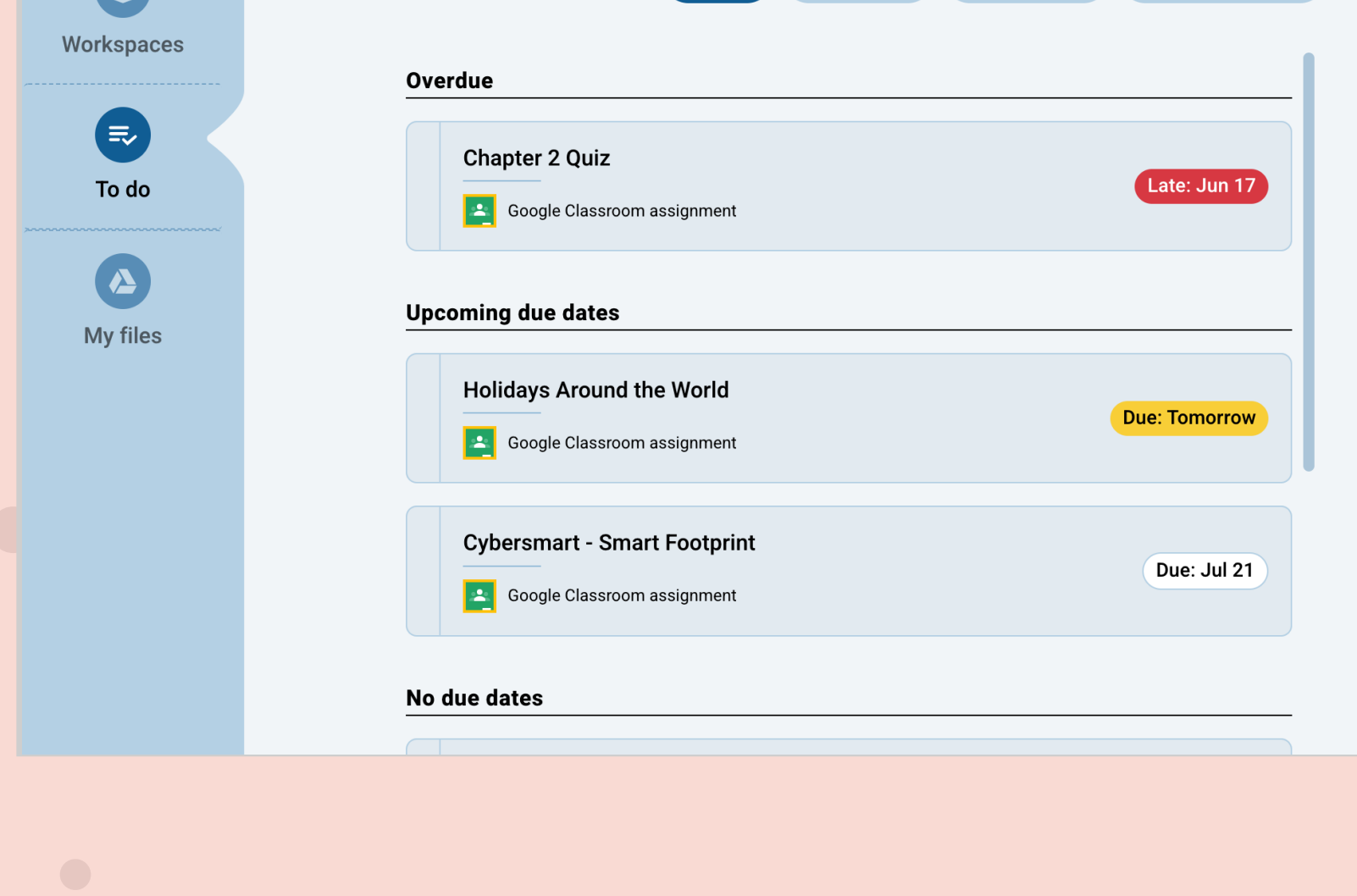
