Analyze, interpret, and apply regulation in relation to financial reporting to ensure accuracy and compliance with the respective legislation.

- Provide accurate and effective responses to a wide range of financial reporting to the respective regulatory body, including average daily transmission liability, permissible investments, capital adequacy and continuous disclosure documents (i.e. financial statements, client trading activity, etc.).
- Exercise financial expertise in applying judgment, accounting applications, and regulatory law for a non-bank financial institution.
- Ensure that all reporting and financial statements adhere to the tight regulatory internal control processes, policies and operating procedures.
- Maintain an accurate and complete trail of supporting documentation for all financial and reporting activities.
- Working interpedently with the CIO and Datasoft (FXOffice) to develop automated systems for timely and concise reporting as it relates to each state the company is licensed in.
- Prepare state licensing applications and ensure the company adheres to and complies with licensing agreements and relative state laws.
- Prepare calculations to ensure the company always maintains suitable base capital and surety bonds based on average daily transmission liabilities.
- Respond to requests for information by state regulators and for state regulatory examinations and assist state examiners as required.
