Introduction:

Truth:

Read Luke 9:1-2, 10-17.

Jesus sends out the Apostles to exercise the power and authority Jesus gives them in order to point to the reality of Jesus. He invites us to do the same.

What is the point of gathering (coming together) in the name of Jesus if we do not also scatter (live “sent”) in the power of Jesus?
