This includes monthly trucking economic indicators, motor carrier financial and operating data, an annual freight transportation forecast, driver wage studies, weekly diesel fuel price and economic reports, a yearly trucking almanac and economic analyses of proposed regulations and legislation affecting the trucking industry. and Cross Border Operations, he works on issues related to NAFTA/USMCA, tariffs, customs, and immigration. Bob currently serves on the American Transportation Research Institute's Research Advisory Committee and is on the Board of Directors for the Border Trade Alliance.

More recently, Mr. Dungy and wife Lauren released a new book entitled "You Can Be a Friend", which teaches children what it means to be a good friend.


