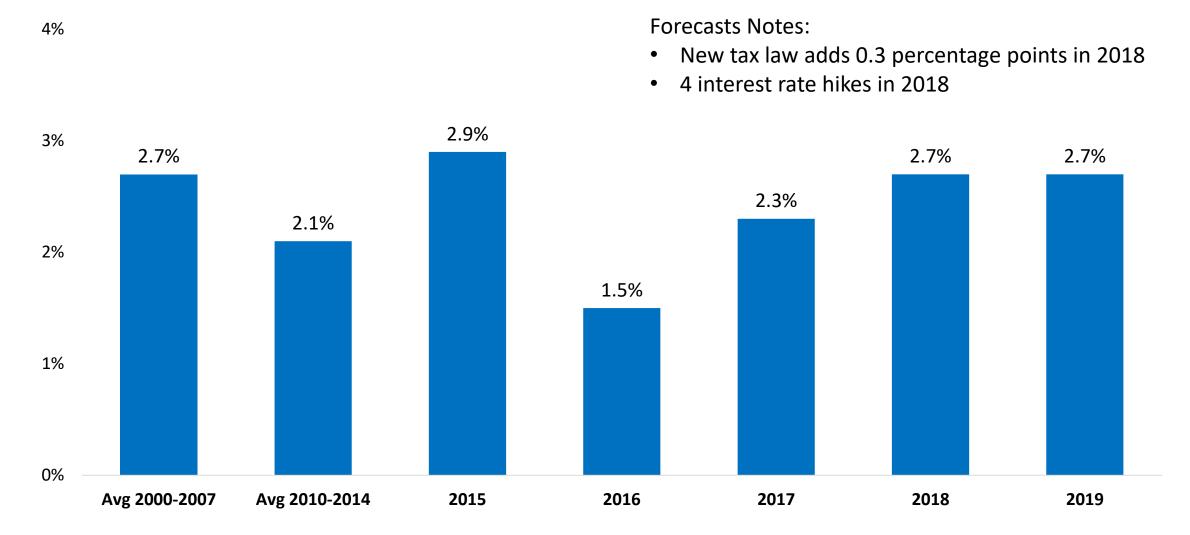

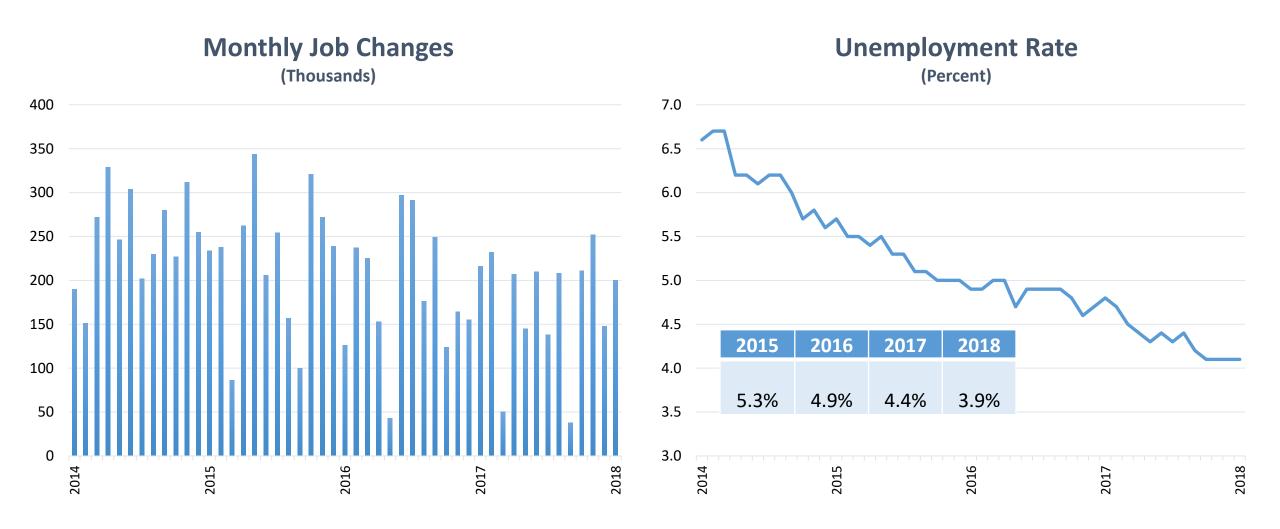


Drivers of Truck Freight

The 3.5 Buckets of Freight

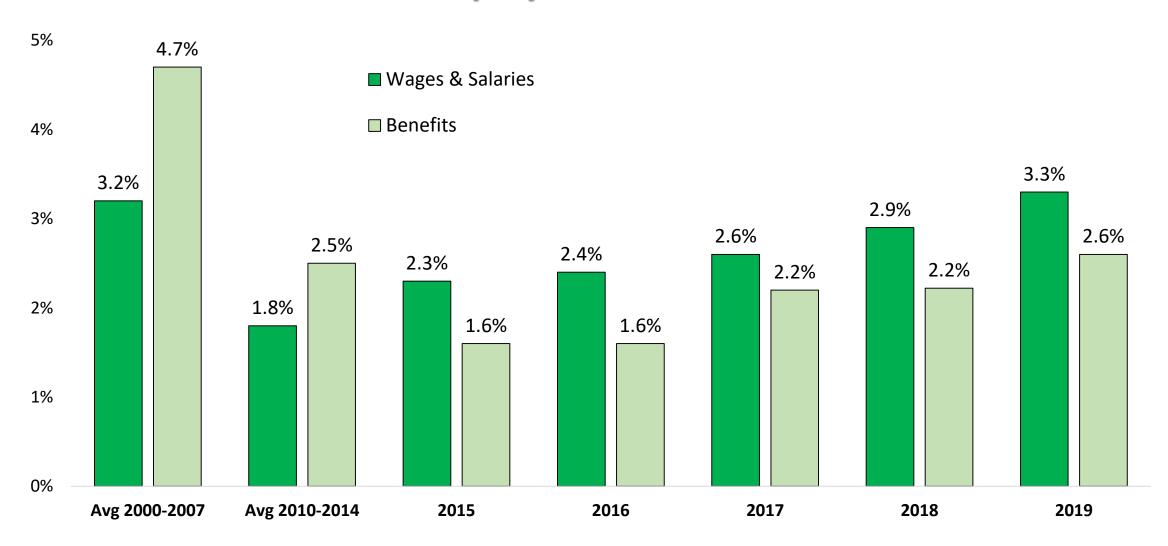

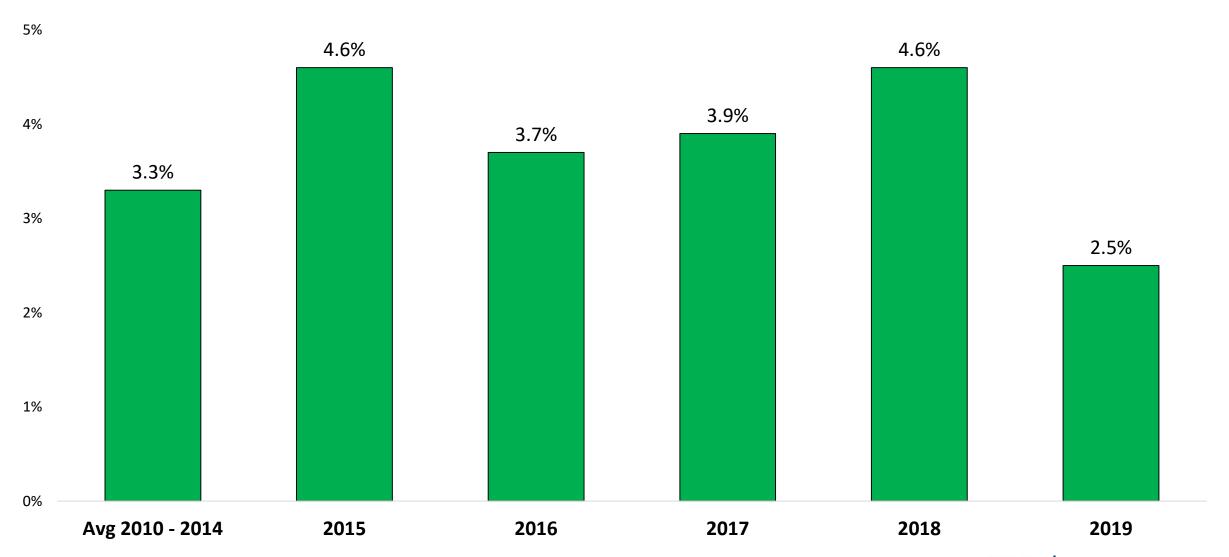

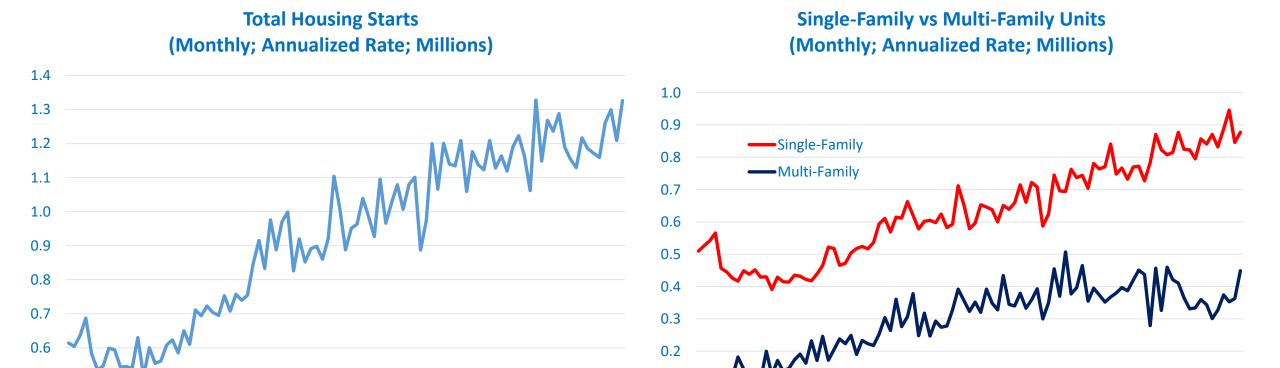
Real Personal Consumption Growth (Goods Only)

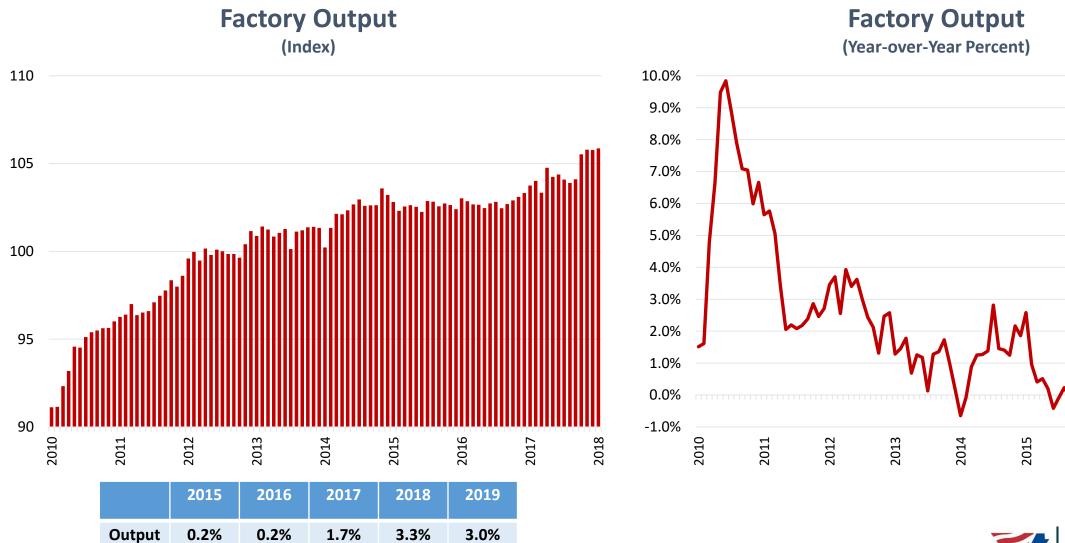

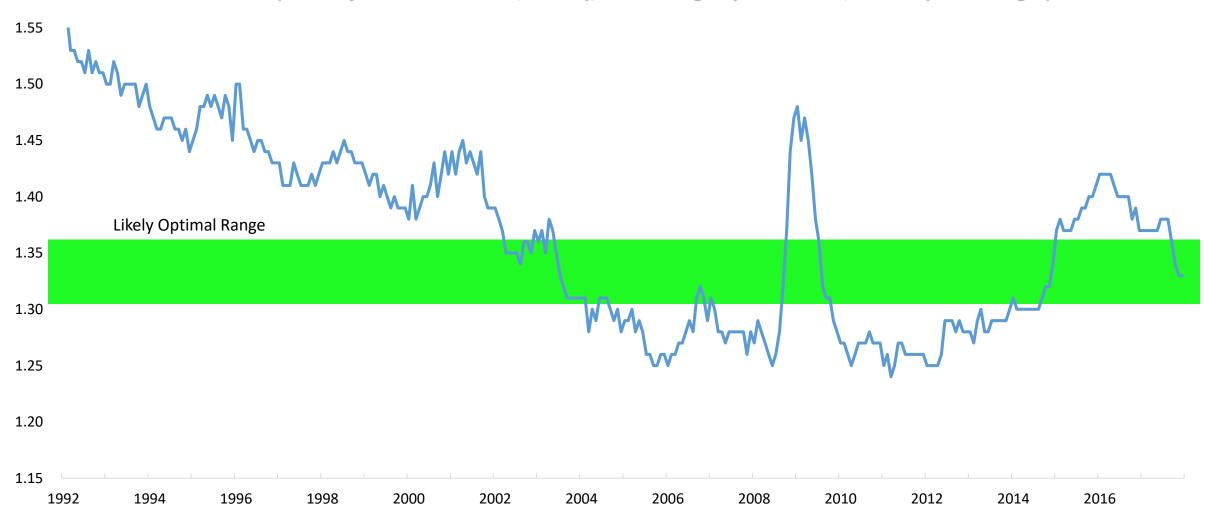

Total Business Inventory-to-Sales Ratio

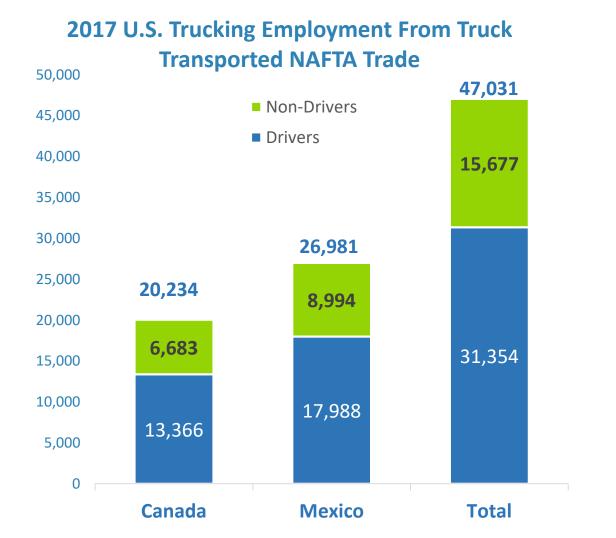

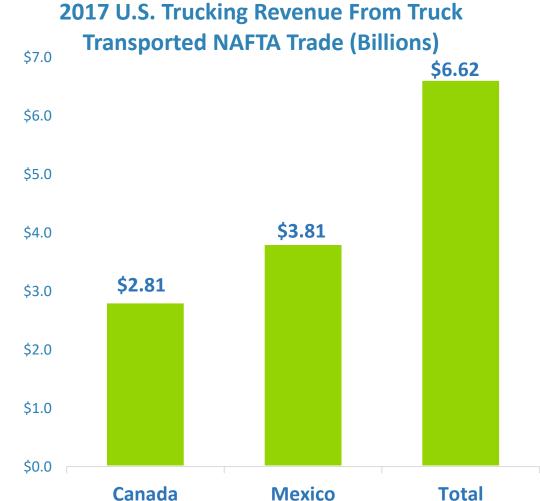

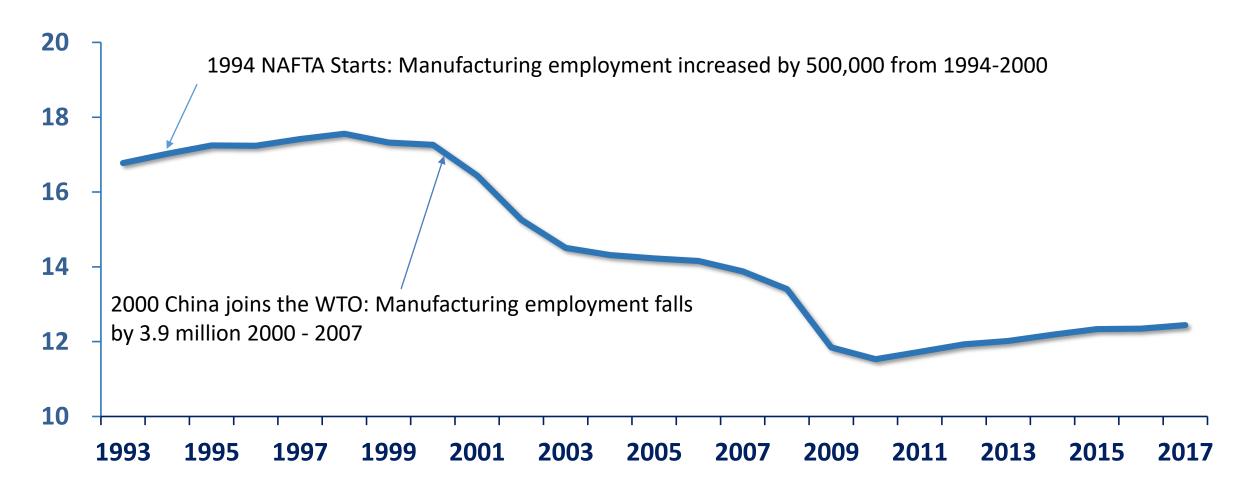






U.S. Manufacturing Employment

Total For-Hire TL Loads

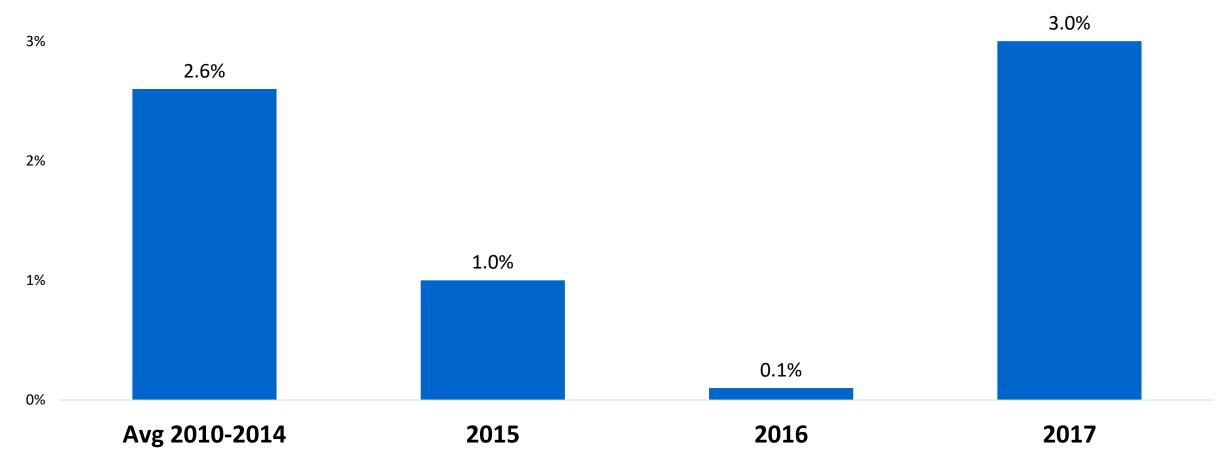

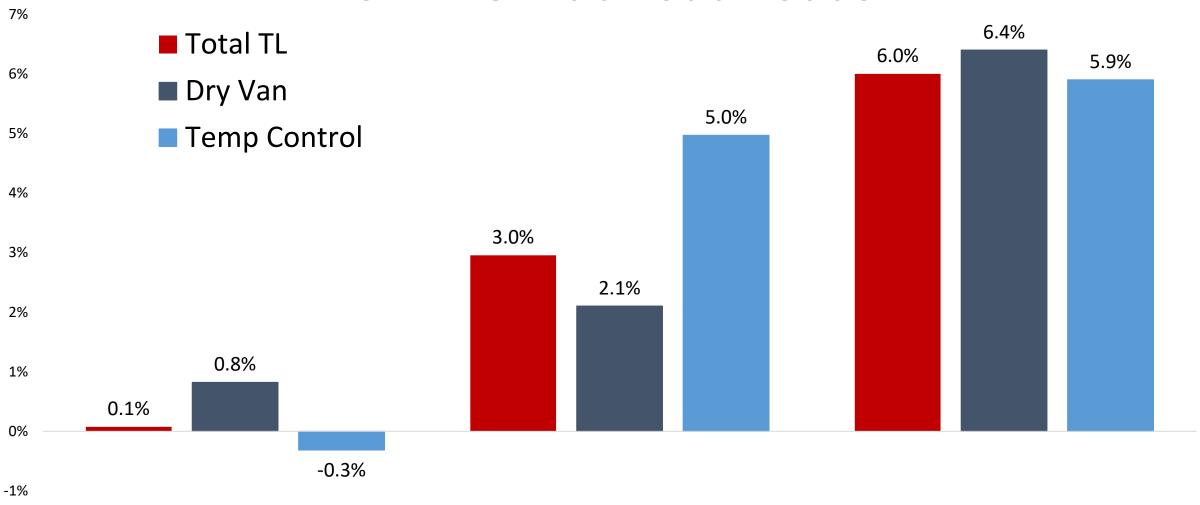

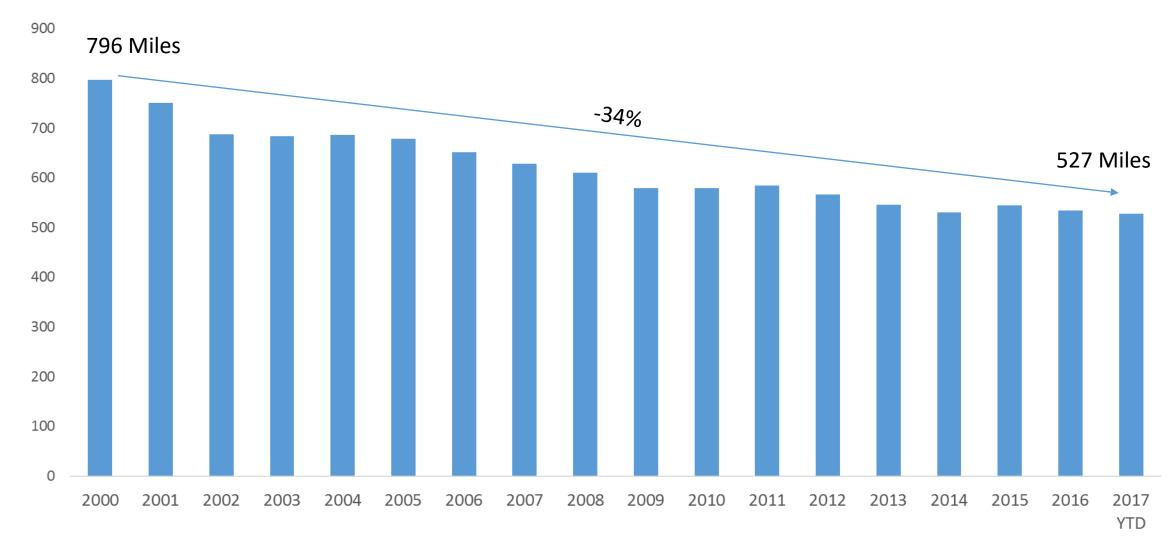

Dry Van Truckload Average Length-Of-Haul is Down

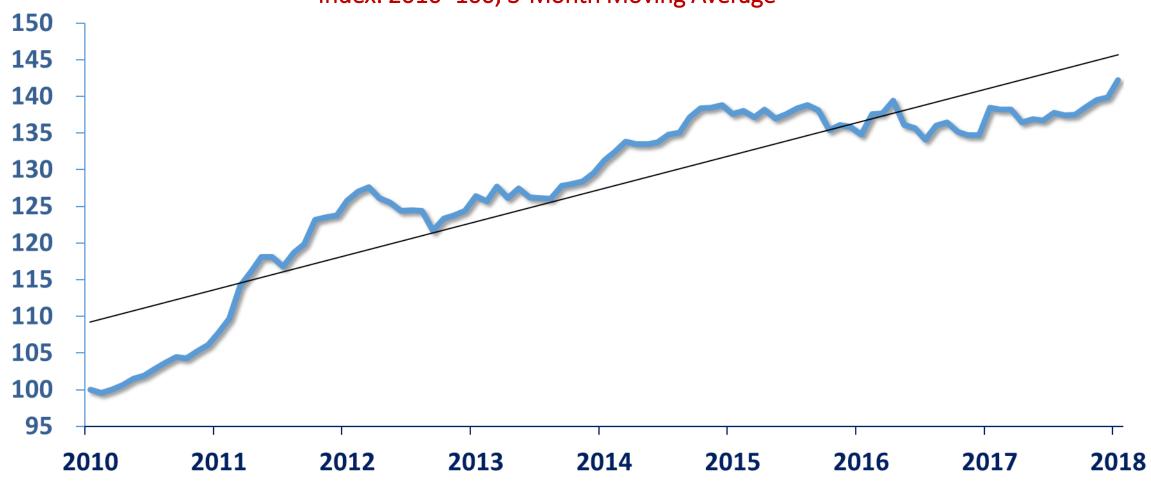

LTL Tonnage

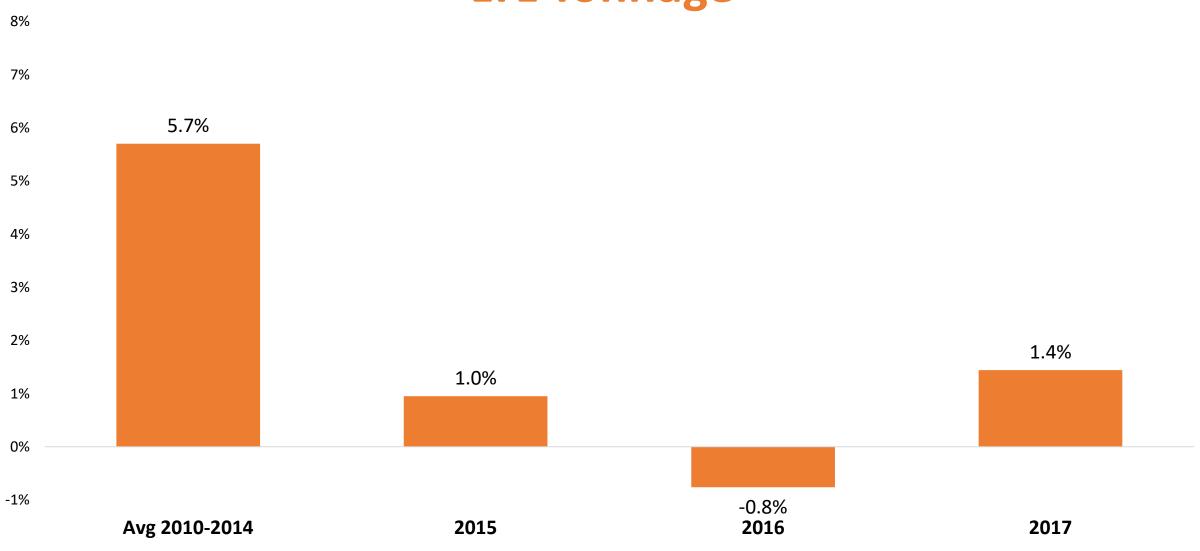

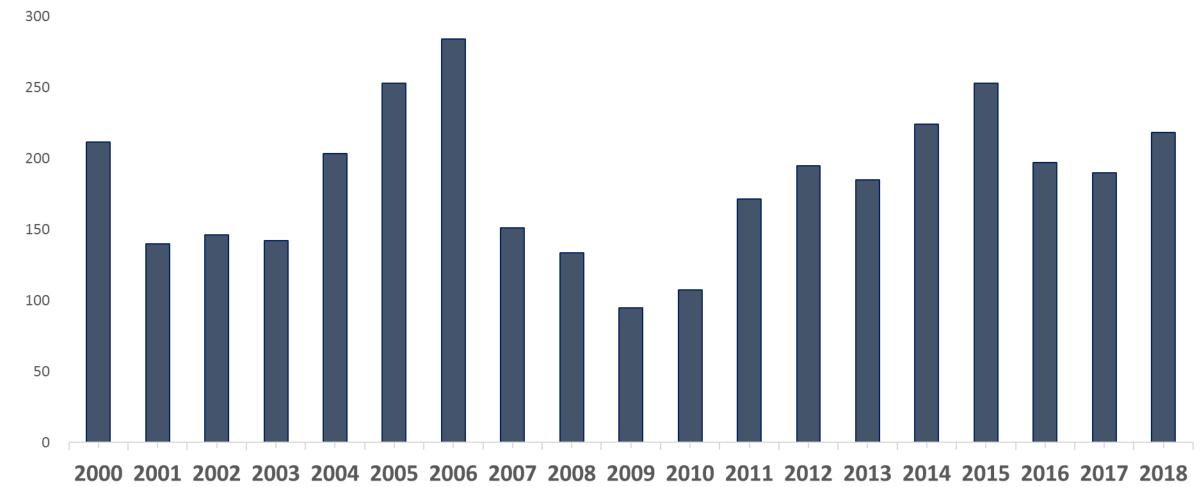


Industry Capacity

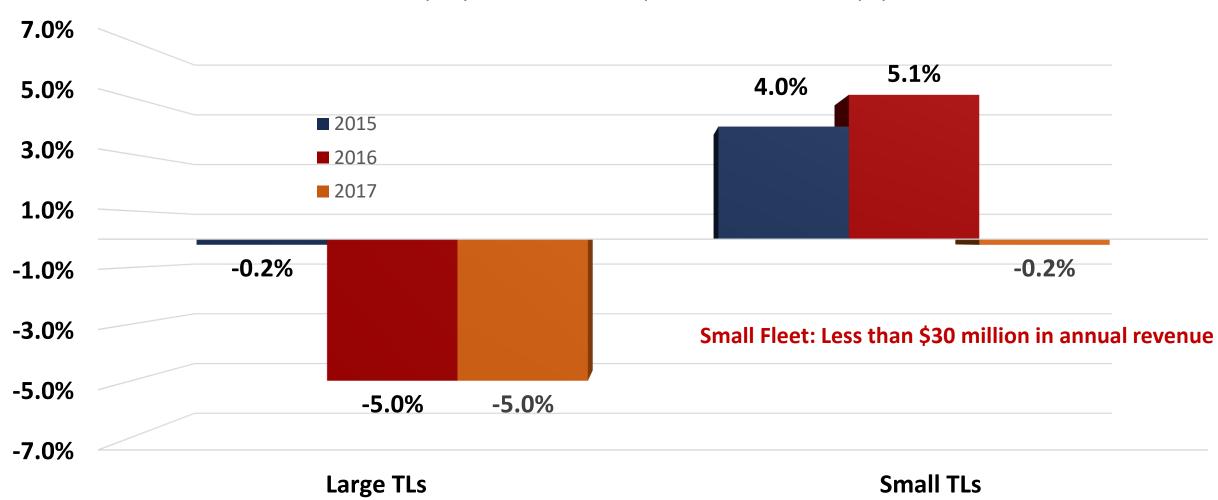

TL Tractor Changes: Large vs Small Fleets

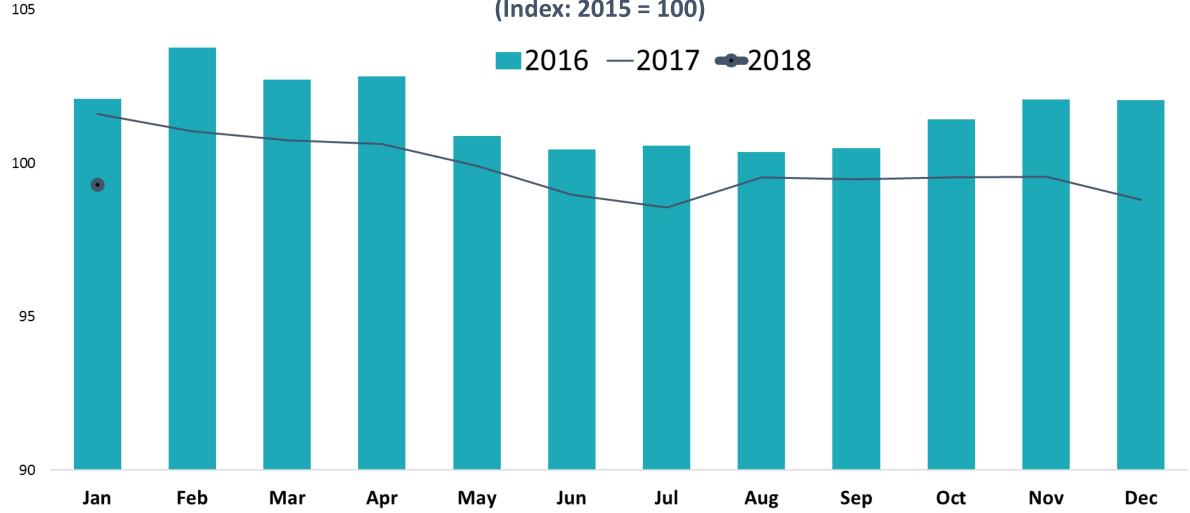

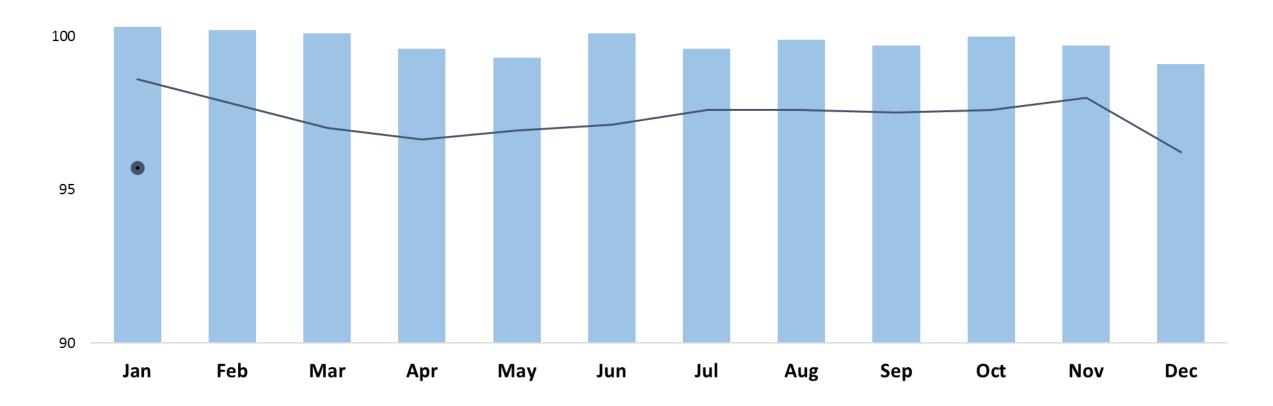

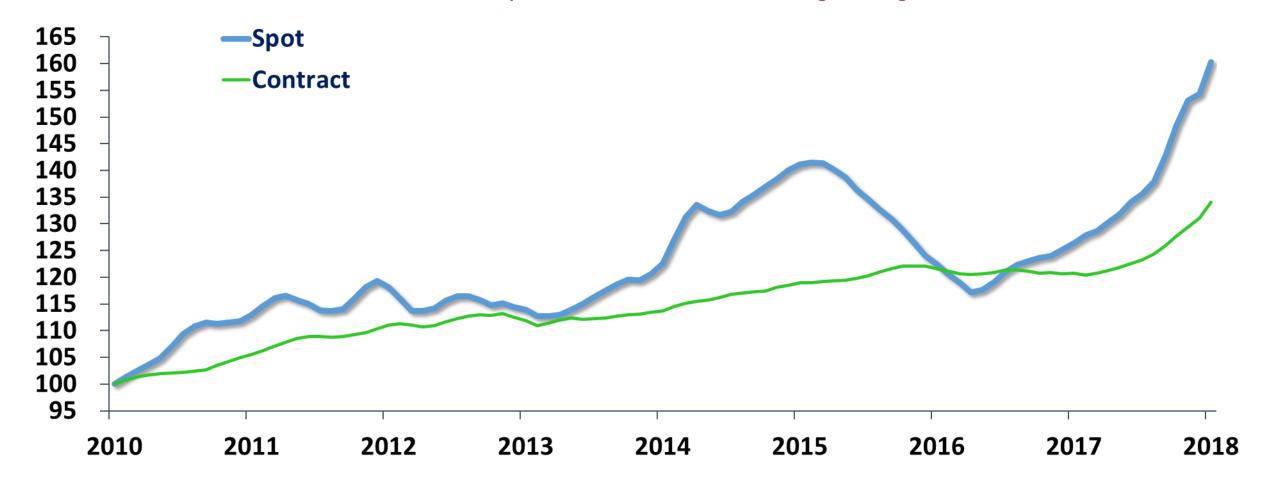

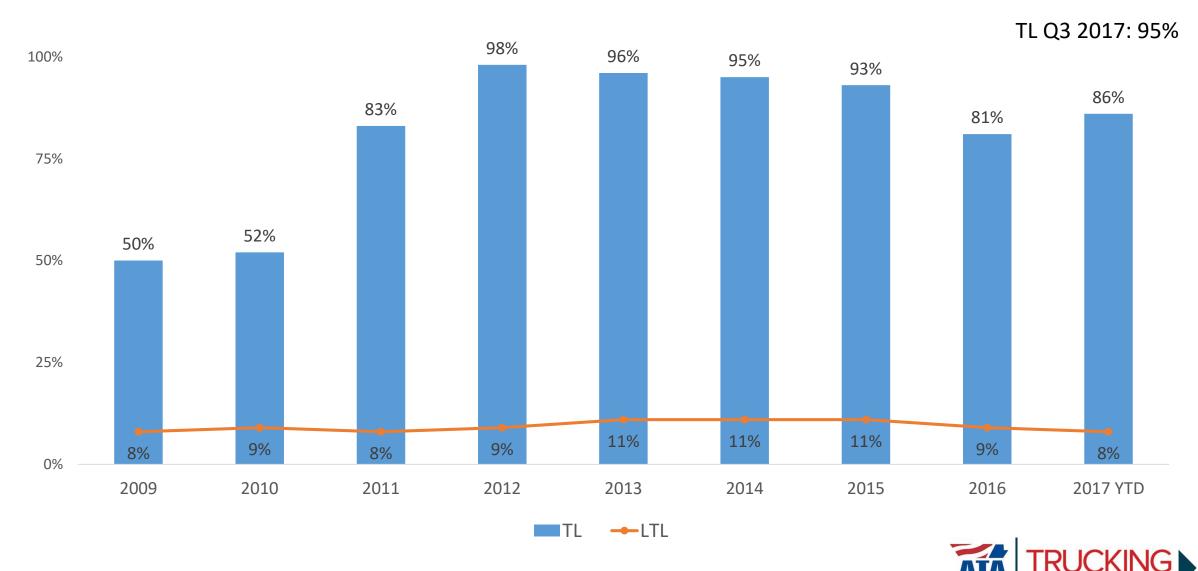

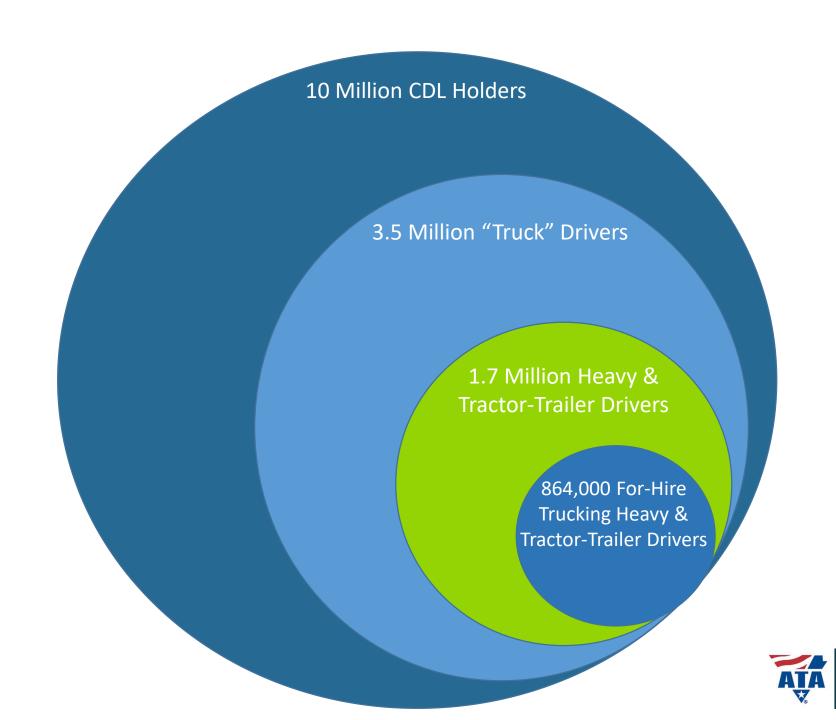

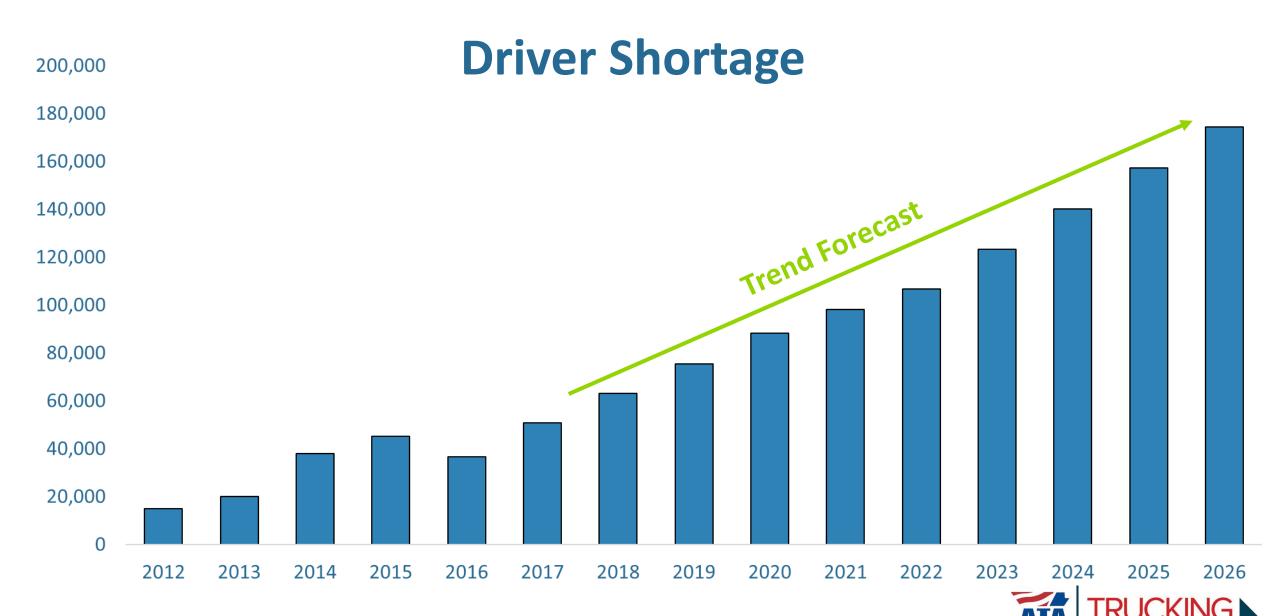


Truck Driver Turnover Rates



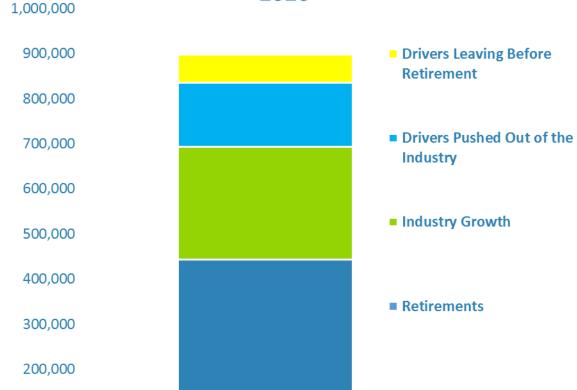

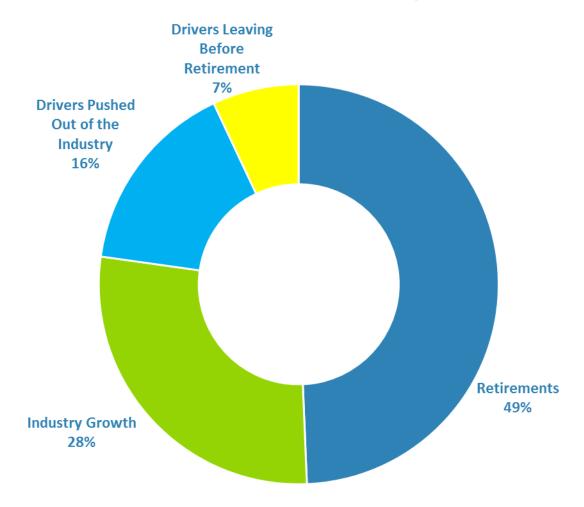

Share of Drivers Needed Through 2026





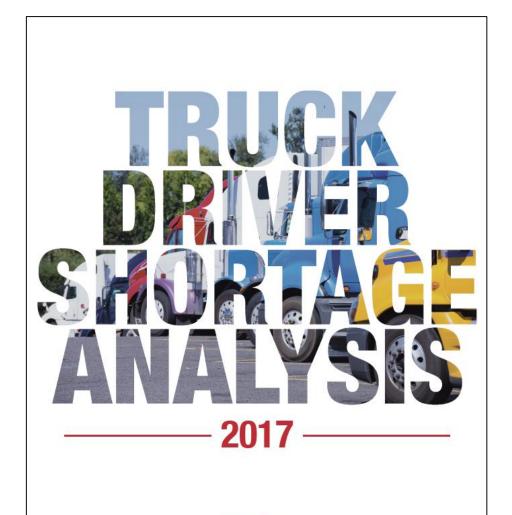
