

FACTS	WHAT DOES SWELL FINANCIAL, INC. (SWELL, WE, US, OUR, OR THE COMPANY) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information Swell collects and shares depends on the product or service you obtain and utilize using the Swell website or the Swell mobile application. This information can include: • Social Security number (or tax identification number) and income • Checking account information and payment history • Credit history and credit scores
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Swell chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do				
How does Swell protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer and mobile application safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards (<i>i.e.</i> , virus protection software, firewalls, encryption). Only authorized employees have access. Customer account access is protected by customer-specific usernames and passwords.			
How does Swell collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you: Open an account or apply for a loan Give us your income information or provide employment information Give us your contact information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, and other companies. 			
Why can't I limit all sharing? What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only: Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness Affiliates from using your information to market you Sharing for non-affiliates to market you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See "Other Important Information" below for more on your rights under state law. Your choices will apply to everyone on your account. 			
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Swell has no affiliates.			
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Non-affiliates we share with can include banks, credit bureaus and similar data providers, lenders, payment processors, investment companies, and other third-party companies that offer consumer financial products and services.			
Joint marketing	Our joint marketing partners may include lenders, banks, payment processors, investment companies, and other third-party companies that offer consumer financial products and services.
