Definitions

Persistence and Completion Rates: While the terms "retention rate" and "graduation rate" generally refer only to students who enter as first-time, full-time students, the rates in this report apply to all students who begin as degree seeking. Completion Rates are only shown for students beginning in 2017-18 or earlier.

Retention Bar Charts




FIGURE 1: RETENTION HEADCOUNT 1ST TO 3RD BY COLLEGE (UNDUPLICATED HEADCOUNT WITHIN COLLEGE)




FIGURE 2: RETENTION RATE 1st to 3rd Semester by College (unduplicated headcount within college)

Our data have shown that we lose the most students between their first and third semesters, so that time frame is of particular interest. The following bar chart shows retention trends within each college from 2012 through 2020 (Figure 1 shows headcount and Figure 2 shows percentage). The rest of the report provides details within in each college, department, and major.

Retention Headcount 1st to 3rd Semester: Compare across Colleges Unduplicated Headcount within College

Retention Percentage 1st to 3rd Semester: Compare across Colleges Unduplicated Headcount within College

College of Bible, Humanities, and Arts TUG Programs

Department-level and Major-level information related to persistence and completions is given for all degree seeking students. This includes: first-time full-time students, transfer students, and part-time students. Students who began their studies in either the fall or spring semester of the given year are included. The data are organized in two categories:

- 1. Those students who declared a major when enrolling at JBU: Since many students change majors at least once, rates are given for persistence and completion of the original department or major and also for persistence and completion at JBU in any major.
- 2. Students who were enrolled in the given major in their 4th semester at JBU: While many students change majors, most students have identified with their final major by their fourth semester. The completion rate of these students earning degrees in the same department or major is given in the last three columns.

Reading the Department-Level Retention Data Tables

For departments with more than one major, there is a department-level retention table that tracks students within the department. For example, reading across a row in department for 2012-13, of all students who entered JBU in Fall 2012 or Spring 2013,

- The first column gives the number of students who began with a major in the department in their first semester. If the student had a double-major within the department, the student is counted only once.
- The second and third columns give the number and percentage of the students who began in the department and in their third semester were still enrolled in the department.
- The fourth and fifth columns give the number and percentage of these same students who were still at JBU (in any major) for their third semester.
- The sixth and seventh columns give the number and percentage of these same students who graduated in their original department within 6 years of their first enrollment.
- The eighth and ninth columns give the percentage of these same students who graduated in any major within 6 years of their first enrollment.
- The last three columns show the number of students entering JBU in 2012-13 who were in this department during their fourth semester at JBU, and the number and percentage of those students who continued and graduated in this department within 6 years of their first enrollment. If the student had a double-major within the department, the student is counted only once.

Retention Bar Charts

Our data have shown that we lose the most students between their first and third semesters, so that time frame is of particular interest. Following the department-level data table is a set of bar charts that show, retention within major/department/college/JBU for each major.

Changes of major

A frequent question of interest is "where do students go when they leave the major?" The table following the bar charts lists majors that students changed to between Semester 1 to Semester 3.

Reading the Major-Level Retention Data Tables

Reading across a row in 2012-13, of all students who entered JBU in Fall 2012 or Spring 2013,

- The first column gives the number of students who began in the major in their first semester.
- The second and third columns give the number and percentage of the students who began in the
 major and in their third semester were still enrolled in the major. The fourth and fifth columns
 give the number and percentage of these same students who were still at JBU (in any major) for
 their third semester.
- The sixth and seventh columns give the number and percentage of these same students who graduated in their original major within 6 years of their first enrollment.

- The eighth and ninth columns give the percentage of these same students who graduated in any major within 6 years of their first enrollment.
- The last three columns show the number of students entering JBU in 2012-13 who were in this major during their fourth semester at JBU, and the number and percentage of those students who continued and graduated in the major within 6 years of their first enrollment.




FIGURE 3: GRAPH OF RETENTION FROM 1st SEMESTER TO 3rd SEMESTER FOR BIBLE & MINISTRY




FIGURE 4: GRAPH OF RETENTION FROM 1ST SEMESTER TO 3RD SEMESTER FOR COMMUNICATION






FIGURE 5: GRAPH OF RETENTION FROM 1ST SEMESTER TO 3RD SEMESTER FOR ENGLISH, HISTORY, AND SPANISH




FIGURE 6: GRAPH OF RETENTION FROM 1ST SEMESTER TO 3RD SEMESTER FOR MUSIC AND THEATRE




FIGURE 7: GRAPH OF RETENTION FROM 1ST SEMESTER TO 3RD SEMESTER FOR MUSIC AND THEATRE

Soderquist College of Business

Department-level and Major-level information related to persistence and completions is given for all degree seeking students. This includes: first-time full-time students, transfer students, and part-time students. Students who began their studies in either the fall or spring semester of the given year are included. The data are organized in two categories:

- Those students who declared a major when enrolling at JBU: Since many students change majors
 at least once, rates are given for persistence and completion of the original department or major
 and also for persistence and completion at JBU in any major.
- 2. Students who were enrolled in the given major in their 4th semester at JBU: While many students change majors, most students have identified with their final major by their fourth semester. The completion rate of these students earning degrees in the same department or major is given in the last three columns.

Reading the Department-Level Retention Data Tables

For departments with more than one major, there is a department-level retention table that tracks students within the department. For example, reading across a row in department for 2012-13, of all students who entered JBU in Fall 2012 or Spring 2013,

- The first column gives the number of students who began with a major in the department in their first semester. If the student had a double-major within the department, the student is counted only once.
- The second and third columns give the number and percentage of the students who began in the department and in their third semester were still enrolled in the department.
- The fourth and fifth columns give the number and percentage of these same students who were still at JBU (in any major) for their third semester.
- The sixth and seventh columns give the number and percentage of these same students who
 graduated in their original department within 6 years of their first enrollment.
- The eighth and ninth columns give the percentage of these same students who graduated in any major within 6 years of their first enrollment.
- The last three columns show the number of students entering JBU in 2012-13 who were in this department during their fourth semester at JBU, and the number and percentage of those students who continued and graduated in this department within 6 years of their first enrollment. If the student had a double-major within the department, the student is counted only once.

Retention Bar Charts

Our data have shown that we lose the most students between their first and third semesters, so that time frame is of particular interest. Following the department-level data table is a set of bar charts that show, retention within major/department/college/JBU for each major.

Changes of major

A frequent question of interest is "where do students go when they leave the major?" The table following the bar charts lists majors that students changed to between Semester 1 to Semester 3.

Reading the Major-Level Retention Data Tables

Reading across a row in 2012-13, of all students who entered JBU in Fall 2012 or Spring 2013,

- The first column gives the number of students who began in the major in their first semester.
- The second and third columns give the number and percentage of the students who began in the major and in their third semester were still enrolled in the major.
- The fourth and fifth columns give the number and percentage of these same students who were still at JBU (in any major) for their third semester.
- The sixth and seventh columns give the number and percentage of these same students who graduated in their original major within 6 years of their first enrollment.






FIGURE 8: GRAPH OF RETENTION FROM 1ST SEMESTER TO 3RD SEMESTER FOR BUSINESS & CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Department-level and Major-level information related to persistence and completions is given for all degree seeking students. This includes: first-time full-time students, transfer students, and part-time students. Students who began their studies in either the fall or spring semester of the given year are included. The data are organized in two categories:

- 1. Those students who declared a major when enrolling at JBU: Since many students change majors at least once, rates are given for persistence and completion of the original department or major and also for persistence and completion at JBU in any major.
- Students who were enrolled in the given major in their 4th semester at JBU: While many students
 change majors, most students have identified with their final major by their fourth semester. The
 completion rate of these students earning degrees in the same department or major is given in
 the last three columns.

Reading the Department-Level Retention Data Tables

For departments with more than one major, there is a department-level retention table that tracks students within the department. For example, reading across a row in department for 2012-13, of all students who entered JBU in Fall 2012 or Spring 2013,

- The first column gives the number of students who began with a major in the department in their first semester. If the student had a double-major within the department, the student is counted only once.
- The second and third columns give the number and percentage of the students who began in the department and in their third semester were still enrolled in the department.
- The fourth and fifth columns give the number and percentage of these same students who were still at JBU (in any major) for their third semester.
- The sixth and seventh columns give the number and percentage of these same students who graduated in their original department within 6 years of their first enrollment.
- The eighth and ninth columns give the percentage of these same students who graduated in any major within 6 years of their first enrollment.
- The last three columns show the number of students entering JBU in 2012-13 who were in this department during their fourth semester at JBU, and the number and percentage of those students who continued and graduated in this department within 6 years of their first enrollment. If the student had a double-major within the department, the student is counted only once.

Retention Bar Charts

Our data have shown that we lose the most students between their first and third semesters, so that time frame is of particular interest. Following the department-level data table is a set of bar charts that show, retention within major/department/college/JBU for each major.

Changes of major

A frequent question of interest is "where do students go when they leave the major?" The table following the bar charts lists majors that students changed to between Semester 1 to Semester 3.

Reading the Major-Level Retention Data Tables

Reading across a row in 2012-13, of all students who entered JBU in Fall 2012 or Spring 2013,

- The first column gives the number of students who began in the major in their first semester.
- The second and third columns give the number and percentage of the students who began in the major and in their third semester were still enrolled in the major.
- The fourth and fifth columns give the number and percentage of these same students who were still at JBU (in any major) for their third semester.

- The sixth and seventh columns give the number and percentage of these same students who graduated in their original major within 6 years of their first enrollment.
- The eighth and ninth columns give the percentage of these same students who graduated in any major within 6 years of their first enrollment.
- The last three columns show the number of students entering JBU in 2012-13 who were in this major during their fourth semester at JBU, and the number and percentage of those students who continued and graduated in the major within 6 years of their first enrollment.




FIGURE 9: GRAPH OF RETENTION FROM 1ST SEMESTER TO 3RD SEMESTER FOR FHS, POLITICAL SCIENCE PSYCHOLOGY, AND SOCIAL STUDIES EDUCATION




FIGURE 10: GRAPH OF RETENTION FROM 1ST SEMESTER TO 3RD SEMESTER FOR TEACHER EDUCATION

Department-level and Major-level information related to persistence and completions is given for all degree seeking students. This includes: first-time full-time students, transfer students, and part-time students. Students who began their studies in either the fall or spring semester of the given year are included. The data are organized in two categories:

- 1. Those students who declared a major when enrolling at JBU: Since many students change majors at least once, rates are given for persistence and completion of the original department or major and also for persistence and completion at JBU in any major.
- 2. Students who were enrolled in the given major in their 4th semester at JBU: While many students change majors, most students have identified with their final major by their fourth semester. The completion rate of these students earning degrees in the same department or major is given in the last three columns.

Reading the Department-Level Retention Data Tables

For departments with more than one major, there is a department-level retention table that tracks students within the department. For example, reading across a row in department for 2012-13, of all students who entered JBU in Fall 2012 or Spring 2013,

- The first column gives the number of students who began with a major in the department in their first semester. If the student had a double-major within the department, the student is counted only once.
- The second and third columns give the number and percentage of the students who began in the department and in their third semester were still enrolled in the department.
- The fourth and fifth columns give the number and percentage of these same students who were still at JBU (in any major) for their third semester.
- The sixth and seventh columns give the number and percentage of these same students who
 graduated in their original department within 6 years of their first enrollment.
- The eighth and ninth columns give the percentage of these same students who graduated in any major within 6 years of their first enrollment.
- The last three columns show the number of students entering JBU in 2012-13 who were in this department during their fourth semester at JBU, and the number and percentage of those students who continued and graduated in this department within 6 years of their first enrollment. If the student had a double-major within the department, the student is counted only once.

Retention Bar Charts

Our data have shown that we lose the most students between their first and third semesters, so that time frame is of particular interest. Following the department-level data table is a set of bar charts that show, retention within major/department/college/JBU for each major.

Changes of major

A frequent question of interest is "where do students go when they leave the major?" The table following the bar charts lists majors that students changed to between Semester 1 to Semester 3.

Reading the Major-Level Retention Data Tables

Reading across a row in 2012-13, of all students who entered JBU in Fall 2012 or Spring 2013,

- The first column gives the number of students who began in the major in their first semester.
- The second and third columns give the number and percentage of the students who began in the major and in their third semester were still enrolled in the major.
- The fourth and fifth columns give the number and percentage of these same students who were still at JBU (in any major) for their third semester.
- The sixth and seventh columns give the number and percentage of these same students who graduated in their original major within 6 years of their first enrollment.

- The eighth and ninth columns give the percentage of these same students who graduated in any major within 6 years of their first enrollment.
- The last three columns show the number of students entering JBU in 2012-13 who were in this major during their fourth semester at JBU, and the number and percentage of those students who continued and graduated in the major within 6 years of their first enrollment.




FIGURE 11: GRAPH OF RETENTION FROM 1ST SEMESTER TO 3RD SEMESTER IN DEPARTMENTS OF BIOLOGY, CHEMISTRY, AND MATHEMATICS




FIGURE 12: GRAPH OF RETENTION FROM 1ST SEMESTER TO 3RD SEMESTER IN COMPUTER SCIENCE DEPARTMENT






FIGURE 13: GRAPH OF RETENTION FROM 1ST SEMESTER TO 3RD SEMESTER FOR ENGINEERING




FIGURE 14: GRAPH OF RETENTION FROM 1ST SEMESTER TO 3RD SEMESTER FOR IN DEPARTMENTS OF KINESIOLOGY AND NURSING
