AM I ELIGIBLE?

To be eligible you must meet one or more of the eligibility criteria below and provide evidence to support your eligibility.

OR

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

EVIDENCE OF ELIGIBILITY

Persons aged 15—24 years at the time of enrolment (excluding school students).

» Present current driver's license, birth certificate or similar.

Secondary school-aged persons who are not enrolled at school. (NOA must be provided)

Persons receiving the JobSeeker or Centrelink payment.

Persons and dependents of persons receiving the Youth Allowance, AUSTUDY or ABSTUDY.

» Evidence or advice from Centrelink that they are in receipt of Jobseeker payments or equivalent.

Persons and dependents of persons holding:

- » Pensioner Concession Card or Health Care Card; or
- » Repatriation Health Benefits Card issued by the Department of Veterans' Affairs.

OR

» Present valid card.
