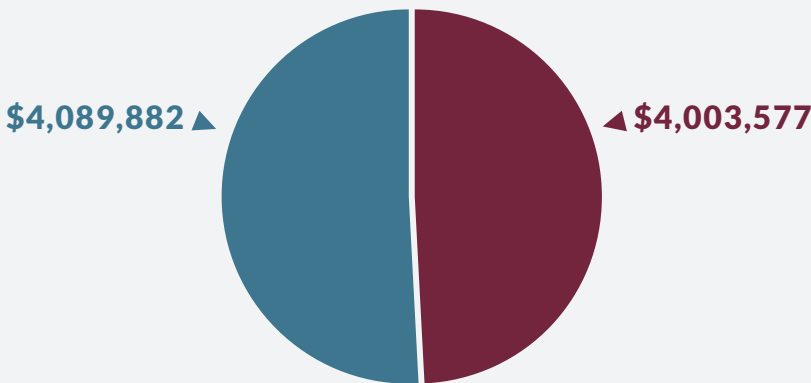


# MULTIPLYING OUR PHILANTHROPIC IMPACT: 2019 YEAR IN REVIEW

**T**he Bradley Impact Fund is a nationwide network of educated, conservative donors dedicated to using their philanthropy to restore, strengthen, and protect the principles and institutions of American exceptionalism and the values that make our country great. The Impact Fund was established in 2012 as an independent 501(c)(3) non-profit with a grant from the Wisconsin-based Lynde and Harry Bradley Foundation, a well-recognized leader in conservative giving.

In 2019, our donors set a record high with their giving, with grants totaling \$8,093,459, a 30% increase over 2018. Whether our donors chose to support a national think tank, a regional advocacy group, or their favorite local nonprofit, their choice to give with the Bradley Impact Fund helped multiply their philanthropic impact. Donors have two important advantages with the Impact Fund: Access to the research and strategic thinking that is behind The Bradley Foundation’s well-vetted portfolio of grantees, and the ability to better protect and advance their donor intent.

Members of the Bradley Impact Fund donor community share The Bradley Foundation’s commitment to advancing a vision for a country invigorated by the principles and institutions that uphold our unalienable rights to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.

In 2019, fifty percent of the charitable investments by Impact Fund donors were made to the 300+ organizations within The Bradley Foundation’s well-vetted portfolio. Through research and close relationships, The Foundation’s professional staff maintains this list of nonprofits proven to successfully advance conservative principles and civil society at the local, state, and national levels.

Members of our donor community also gave 50% of their grants to related organizations across the country.

## Flexibility in Giving

Bradley Impact Fund community members took advantage of three options for giving in 2019:

**PERSONAL GIVING ACCOUNTS**—25 new donor-advised fund accounts were opened last year. Our community used their Personal Giving Accounts to support a variety of local and national organizations. The types of nonprofits most funded in 2019 included art and music organizations, policy and religious institutions, local schools, and many others.

**BRADLEY IMPACT PARTNERSHIP FUND**—many donors chose to pool their gifts with others in the Impact Fund community by giving to this philanthropic mutual fund, which supports activities across a select group of grant recipients. These organizations are recognized for innovative ideas and best-in-class programs, and are drawn from the 300+ pool in the well-vetted Bradley Foundation grant recipient portfolio.
