**Q) Why is Jesus' death and resurrection so important?**

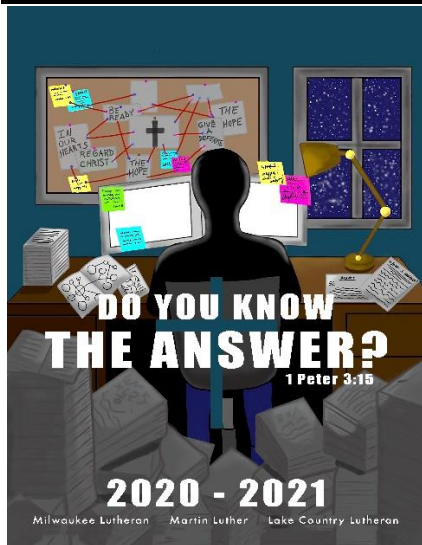
**A) To give thanks**

Our theme for the year focuses on the idea that we need to be prepared to answer the questions for the reason for the hope that we have. There are questions that non-Christians have of Christians in relation to our faith. Throughout the year we will focus on answers to these questions through a lens on the central figure to our faith – Jesus Christ.

We have spent much of the year focusing on the action of Jesus Christ – His divinity, His presence in this world, and His actions that led to our salvation. So what is our response? We were created to worship. We were created to proclaim His wonderful deeds. A reminder that we have a different schedule next week due to Professional Development on Friday. Group A will be in the building Monday and Tuesday (Feb 1 and 2). Group B will be in the building Wednesday and Thursday (Feb 3 and 4). There will be no school on Friday, Feb 5.

According to our plan that we submitted to the Milwaukee Health Dept., our building is open to students from 7:15-4:15. With it being colder outside, it is very important that students are picked up from school before 4:15.

### Arrival To School

- The earliest students can enter the building is 7:15.
- Please aim for arrival by 7:50 as classes begin at 8:00. Students need to be on time.

### Dress Code

- Masks must be worn in the building. If a student is a repeat offender of not bringing a mask to school, they will be charged \$2 for a mask.
- Rips/Tears/Frays are not allowed in jeans or any other clothing
- No writing on shirts is allowed unless it is a Christian message, a team/school, or a name brand. T-shirts with musicians, movies, and tv shows are not allowed.
- If a student is out of dress code, they will not be allowed in class.

### Parking Permit/Driving

- If a student is parking in the school parking lot, they need to either renew their permit from last year or get a parking permit. The cost is \$10. Please see Ms. Adams regarding parking permits.

## Checklist to Become a Red Knight

MILWAUKEE LUTHERAN HIGH SCHOOL 2021-2022 School Year

**ALL STEPS must be completed for your child to attend MLHS.**

You need both **ACADEMIC ACCEPTANCE** and a **CHOICE SEAT or TUITION PLAN** to be accepted and enrolled at MLHS.

- Complete an online application** at [www.milwaukeeelutheran.org](http://www.milwaukeeelutheran.org). Click on Admissions tab at the top and “Get Started.”
- Register for a Placement Exam.** Students will register to take the Placement Exam on the online application.
- Take a **VIRTUAL Placement Exam** at MLHS (upcoming dates are either December 5<sup>th</sup> or January 23)
- After a Placement Test has been taken, you will receive your test results and a **Next Step Letter**.  
If academically accepted, you will be prompted to finish an enrollment form. To enroll, either log back into your online application or use the link found in your ‘New Student Welcome’ email.

**Remember to set up a payment plan in February!** (see next step)

- Starting February 1, 2021, apply for a **Choice Seat** OR set up a **Tuition Payment Plan**:
  - Choice:** Apply online for a MPCP seat (February 1 – 22, April 1 – 20, July 1 – 20, 2021) or a WPCP seat (February 1, – April 15, 2021). When Choice Seats are filled, a wait list will be started.  
**APPLY EARLY!** (see Milwaukee/Wisconsin Parental Choice Programs sheet)
  - Tuition:** After being academically accepted, enroll & set up a billing agreement. To enroll, either log back into your online application or use the link found in your ‘New Student Welcome’ email.
- Select Classes.** We will contact you in the Spring to sign up for a Freshman Course Selection Night only **AFTER Academic Acceptance AND a Choice Seat or Tuition Plan** are verified.

## 2021-2022 School Year CHOICE Programs Application Process Begins Soon!

This is a reminder to all our current families that our first MPCP Open Enrollment Period begins February 1, 2021 and ends February 22, 2021 (WPCP is February 1 - April 15, 2021). The online application process remains the same as last year and you will be able to log in starting **MONDAY, February 1**, at the following link with the email and password that you used last year: [www.dpi.wi.gov/choice](http://www.dpi.wi.gov/choice)

### EVERY CURRENT CHOICE STUDENT MUST RE-APPLY EVERY YEAR!

If you aren't a current Choice family and think that you may qualify for the CHOICE program this year, go to the above link and click on 2021-2022 Income Limits to see if you qualify. It is **STRONGLY** recommended that you apply for CHOICE during the February open enrollment period, as all our MPCP seats will be filled during that month, and you will be on a wait list if you apply after February – we can NOT guarantee your student a CHOICE seat at Milwaukee Lutheran if you apply during a later open enrollment period!

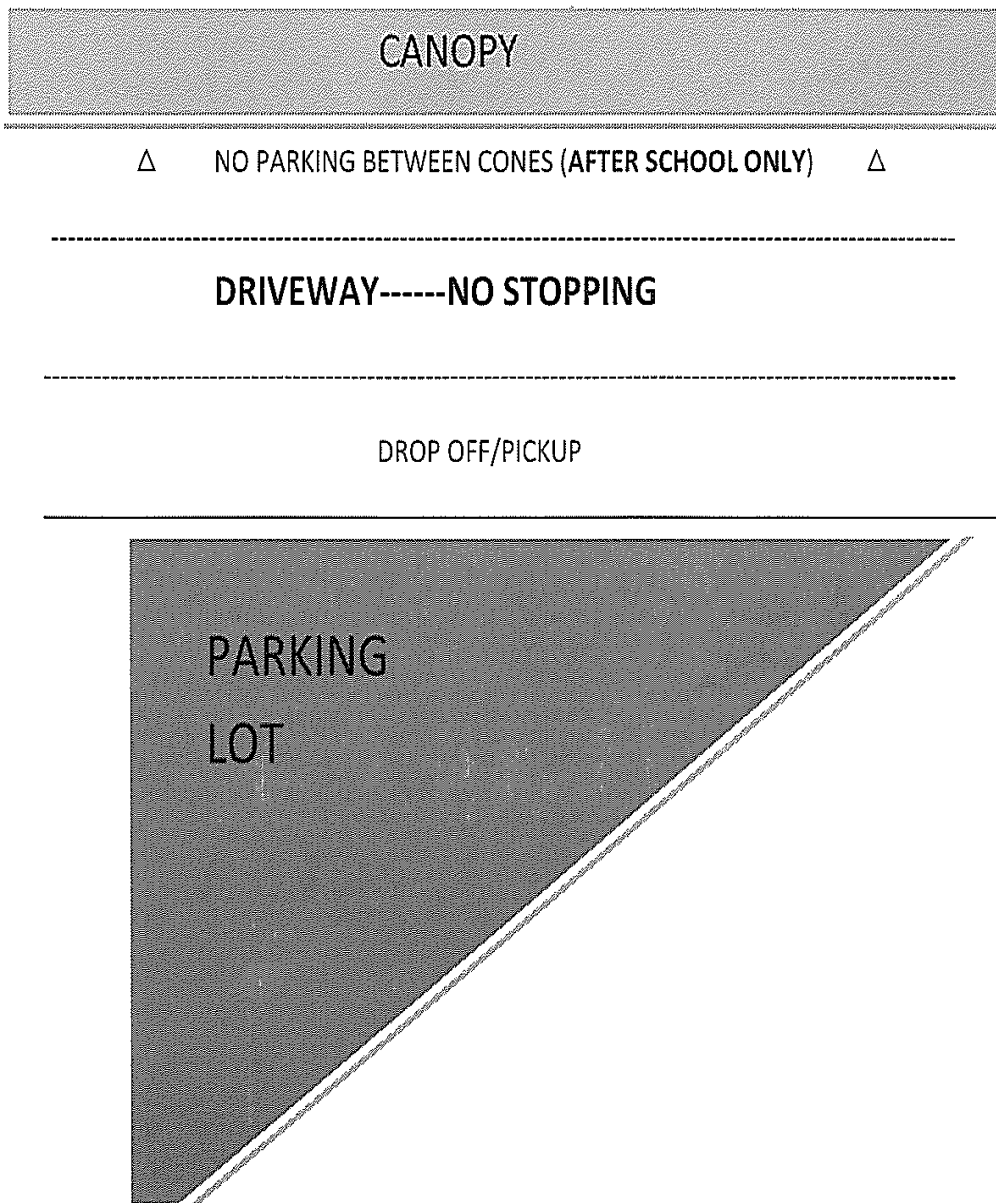
