MILWAUKEE LUTHERAN HIGH SCHOOL 2021-2022 School Year

Question: What do I need to do to become a Red Knight?

Answer: Here is a link to our '[Checklist to Become a Red Knight](#)' document. Essentially, there are 2 separate applications needed: one to Milwaukee Lutheran **AND** one for a Choice seat.

- For the Milwaukee Lutheran Application, visit our admissions website at www.milwaukeeelutheran.org/get-started Scroll down until you see "Click Here to Apply Online through TADS" under the Academic Acceptance section. This is where you will also sign up to take our required **Placement Test**.
- For the Choice application, during an open enrollment period, apply by visiting <https://sms.dpi.wi.gov/ChoiceParent/>.
- If your family is not eligible for choice, please reach out to Mrs. Janousky at rjanousky@milwaukeeelutheran.org. She is happy to walk you through your scholarship options and the tuition process.

Question: Where do I go to apply?

Answer: Visit our admissions website at www.milwaukeeelutheran.org/get-started Scroll down until you see "Click Here to Apply Online through TADS" under Academic Acceptance.

Question: How do I sign up for the placement test?

Answer: You will sign up for one of the placement tests when you apply. The current remaining placement test dates option is Saturday, January 23rd. This test is virtual and you will be sent instructions on how to access the test the day before.

Question: Can I schedule a tour?

Question: When can I apply for choice?

Answer: Open Choice enrollment for the 2021-22 School year begins February 1 -22, 2021 for Milwaukee residents (MPCP) and February 1 – April 15, 2021 for residents outside of the City of Milwaukee (WPCP).

Question: What if my student is already in the choice program? Do I need to reapply?

Answer: Yes. Parents must apply for a Choice seat EVERY year. However, if you are a continuing choice student, you will only need to do the application and provide a new residency document during the Open Choice Enrollment period. You will not have to prove income.

Question: What happens if we receive more choice applications than there are seats?

Answer: If we receive more applications than seats available, seats will be given out on a random basis. If your student does not get a seat, they will be placed on our waiting list. Current students will receive the first-Choice seats for their grade.

Question: How do I know if I will qualify for one of the Choice programs?

Answer: To see if you qualify for Choice based on family size, visit www.dpi.wi.gov/choice.

Answer: MLHS currently has 866 total students. 254 of the 866 are 9th graders. MLHS has 786 total Choice students in the MPCP & WPCP programs.
