JUNIOR YEAR

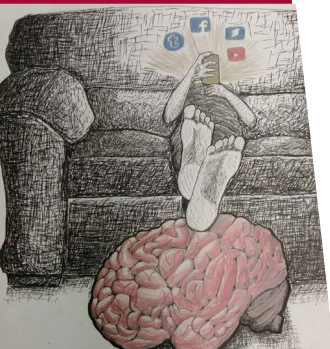
Advanced artists enhance their skills through project-based learning by creating a portfolio of work through their choice of the following media:
