Honors Seminar

Honors seminar is a weekly seminar course which manages the Honors Academy experience. Beginning their sophomore year, students will receive college coaching, career mentoring, leadership training, and instruction for the college application process.

Leadership Lecture Series

Influential leaders are invited to address students on a monthly basis. The predominant focus is upon highlighting leaders who make a difference in their local, state, and national communities.

College Tours

Students have the opportunity to take tours of college campuses throughout various regions of the United States.

Standardized Test Preparation

Additional standardized test preparation services for the ACT and PSAT are incorporated into Honors Seminar. On average, students in the Honors Academy score seven points higher than the state average on the ACT.

Enriched Graduation Requirements

Enriched graduation requirements include taking ten or more Honors/Advanced Placement/Dual Credit courses throughout a student's high school career.

Capstone Project

Graduating seniors from the Honors Academy will engage in a capstone project for school improvement. Projects range from service to the community, academics, and school culture. Students have the opportunity to leave a lasting legacy at Milwaukee Lutheran through their capstone project.
