


CHOICE - Apply online during open enrollment period in February before the following school year. Milwaukee Parental Choice Program (MPCP) for residents in the city of Milwaukee, and Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) for families that live outside of the cities of Milwaukee or Racine.
