The WIB-FAST program is open to early-stage **female** (**co-)founders** of prerevenue life sciences companies developing highly innovative technologies to make a meaningful impact on human or environmental health who might have current challenges with raising capital (Angel, Seed or Series A), commercialization or business plan, funding, legal or scientific strategy.

2022 WIB-FAST Timeline

- March 11, 2022 2022: WIB-FAST applications due
- March 18, 2022 2022: WIB-FAST participants announced
- May 2, 2022: Program start
- Week of June 13, 2022: WIB-FAST companies will present in a dedicated track within Startup Stadium at the BIO International Convention and at the WIB-FAST Closing in San Diego this June.

CLS is currently accepting applications for the 2022 session of WIB-FAST. To apply, email your non-confidential executive summary, cover page and introductory deck to FASTCA@califesciences.org by *no later than close of business*Friday, March 11, 2022.

Application Details All submissions must be non-confidential

Provide a cover page answering the questions below:

- What is your product or service?
- Describe current stage of development and future plans.
- What differentiates you from your competitors?
- What is your next inflection point? What do you need to reach it?
- What needs do you wish to address through the FAST program?
- What are your current challenges?

Provide your Executive Summary and introductory slide deck (or a summary document of no more than 5 pages) with the following information below.

We evaluate submissions on a rolling basis. However, we must receive your application for the 2022 session no later than close of business Friday, March 11, 2022.

WIB-FAST is modeled upon the CLS FAST Program:

Since launching in Fall 2013, FAST program cycles have generated more than 9000 advisory hours valued at over \$2M for the 96 companies who have been through the program. Since participating in FAST, these companies have raised >\$2.2B and created over 770 new jobs, more than tripling their workforce. Over 34 of these companies have secured Series A and beyond, and 21 have concluded strategic partnerships.

The FAST Advisory Program provides select entrepreneurs with intensive team review and coaching to perfect their business model and product development plans and to build a compelling commercialization strategy. Experienced entrepreneurs, product, and business experts (which may include clinical development, regulatory, legal, reimbursement and business development specialists) advise selected startups.
