

About CPPS

- Launched in 2012 by the Certification Board for Professionals in Patient Safety (CBPPS) at the National Patient Safety Foundation
- Rigorous and comprehensive credentialing process that attest to patient safety competencies and expertise
- Evidence-based examination covers 5 patient safety domains:
 - Culture
 - Leadership
 - Patient Safety Risks and Solutions
- Measuring and Improving performance
- Systems thinking and Design / Human Factors

- 1 hour of independent Affinity Group participation





Application and Interview Process

- Applications due August 27, 2021 at 5:00 PM ET
- Video interviews will be conducted late August/early September
- Admission decisions communicated to all applicants on or before
 October 8, 2021
- Program begins December 1, 2021
 (Virtual meet-and-greet/tech training November 17, 2021)



Tuition: \$22,000
