



Divisions and Services Profile

Incorporated in 2009 in Williams Lake, British Columbia, IRWIN'S Safety is an Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) services company, providing a one-stop shop for every OHS requirement. We currently have offices in Calgary, Kelowna, Prince George, Prince Rupert, and Maple Ridge to offer our services across Western Canada.

Our company is structured around four divisions, each providing a unique set of OHS services complementing each other. These services include:

Safety Consulting

This division provides our expertise on site safety. Some examples include First Aid Drills, Confined Space Hazard Assessments, Safe Work Permitting, Lock-out-tag-out, etc. We also provide safety consulting for OHS program development, auditing and site safety services. This division provides expertise on local BC and Alberta OHS guidelines and regulations as well as medical services (e.g. EMR and First Aid, Drug, Alcohol and Respirator Fit testing).

Safety Training

This division consists of several employees and contractors with years of experience in training & education. Our development team puts together industrial safety courses such as Fall Protection, using an interactive approach, leveraging up-to-date technologies to keep students engaged while putting a heavy weight on practical training using state-of-the-art facilities. At our training centres, we teach the full suite of industrial safety training, including courses developed by us and those developed by third parties.

Turnarounds

This division provides safety management during planned and unplanned outages at major facilities. During turnaround projects, Irwin's Safety takes accountability for the safety of up to 1,500 contractors. Some examples of services include training, respiratory fit testing, drug testing, confined space hazard assessments, assistance with the permitting process, rescue planning, and a host of safety staffing with one goal: keep the workers safe.

Field Services

This division encompasses emergency response and industrial labour services. Emergency response includes, but is not limited to: the formulation of rescue plans for remote, industrial sites and the provision of NFPA-trained rescue staff to ensure they are carried out. Emergency response services are not taken lightly by Irwin's Safety - our staff conduct weekly drills while on-site, and at annual practical training.
