PUBLIC HEALTH (COVID-19 EMERGENCY POWERS) AMENDMENT (NO. 3)
REGULATIONS 2020

His Excellency the Governor, on the advice of the Minister of Health, and in exercise of the power conferred by section 107B of the Public Health Act 1949, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations, which amend the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Regulations 2020 (“the principal Regulations”), may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Emergency Powers) Amendment (No. 3) Regulations 2020.

Amends regulation 6A

2 Regulation 6A of the principal Regulations is amended—

(a) by inserting after paragraph (3)—

“(3A) A police officer of the rank of superintendent or above may, upon reasonable belief that a contravention of these Regulations has occurred on a licensed premises, order any licensed person, his servant or his agent carrying on business at the licensed premises, to close the licensed premises for a period not exceeding 24 hours.”; and

(b) in paragraph (4), by inserting after the definition of “intoxicating liquor”—

“ “licensed person” or “licensed premises” have the meanings given in section 1(1) of the Liquor Licence Act 1974.”.
