

The Ministry of Health to <u>prompt</u> a prevention, diagnosis and treatment plan against Covid-19 in the country. British ambassador and Bolivian Minister of Health <u>met</u> to discuss coopera
	Economic	 Government to boost economic measures amid the pandemic crisis. President Luis Arce announced new measures for SME's amid the recovery phase.
	Country Opening	Chile and Bolivia to <u>evaluate</u> reopening of borders.
Outlook	Political	 Congress <u>coordinates</u> the creation of special laws to reform the judicial system, according to local press. 	Country Opening	 Ecuador and Colombia are <u>coordinating</u> the reopening of borders to reactivate the economy, according to both presidents.
Outlook	Political	 The National Assembly <u>approved</u> the removal of the Minister of Government for her intervention in the 2019 protests. The Health Commission in the National Assembly is <u>analyzing</u> the new process of Reverse Auction of Medicines. The National Electoral Council (CNE) <u>called</u> <u>on</u> the international community to accompany and observe the organization of the upcoming elections.
	Social	 Cleaning service workers of public hospitals <u>protested</u> to demand that the Government pay their due wages. The Prosecutor's Office <u>reported</u> that it began an exhumation process as part of the investigation regarding dozens of dead disappeared during the pandemic. Nurses also <u>protested</u> in Quito against the recently published Humanitarian Law.
	Economic	• The Ministry of Economy <u>expects</u> to receive 2 billion USD from the IMF in upcoming weeks.

Pfizer <u>delivered</u> to COFEPRIS the request for the sanitary registration of its COVID-19 vaccine. In upcoming weeks AstraZeneca will <u>present</u> to COFEPRIS the first results of its clinical study of the COVID-19 vaccine. According to the Health Secretariat, a test to simultaneously detect COVID-19 and influenza will soon be available.

	Country Opening	 Due to COVID-19, the Foreign Affairs Secretariat <u>asked</u> the population to avoid non-essential trips during December. Some COVID-19 hospitals in Mexico City are beginning to <u>report</u> they have no more capacity once again.
Outlook	Political	 The Public Function Secretariat <u>reported</u> that within a month nine contractors of the Health sector were sanctioned. AMLO <u>presented</u> the "Ethical Guide for the Transformation of Mexico".
	Social	 The Health Commission in Congress discussed tobacco control initiatives with federal officials. A reform approved in the Senate contemplates the creation of the Mexican Institute for the Regulation and Control of Cannabis. IMSS reported advances in the implementation of a public policy for the care of pediatric oncology patients
	Economic	 The private initiative <u>agreed</u> with President AMLO to review the recently announced reforms to the Outsourcing Law. Banco de Mexico <u>consideres</u> that the economic recovery will be difficult and might be prolonged until mid-2024.


