

COUNTRY HIGHLIGHTS

Argentina: Argentina receives USD 4355 million from the IMF and will use it to meet maturities with international organizations during the rest of the year.

Bolivia: Over 300,000 Sputnik V vaccines to arrive this week in the country to reinforce second dose completion.

Brazil: Fewest COVID-19 deaths recorded since the start of 2021, as vaccines become widely available.

Colombia: Government confirmed vaccine booster shots for population at risk.

Chile: For the first time since the pandemic began, no commune is under quarantine

Ecuador: The government sent to the National Assembly the proposal for the 2021 General Budget.

Mexico: COFEPRIS authorized the Moderna vaccine for its emergency use.

Paraguay: Forest fires raise concerns within government officials.

Peru: The government extended the night curfew and the state of health emergency.

Uruguay: Minister of Tourism resigns amidst controversy over advertising contracting scandal without bidding process

	Health	 The country has recorded a <u>steady decline</u> in COVID-19 cases over the past 12 weeks. Health Minister <u>submitted</u> preliminary conclusions of study evaluating vaccine combinations. While combined schedules "do not generate more adverse effects" they do increase antibody levels compared to non-combined schemes.
	Vaccine Rollout	 Argentina <u>surpassed</u> 47 million vaccines received. During August, more than 4 million second-dose shots were applied. Approximately 32% of the total population has received the <u>complete schedule</u>. Spain <u>donates</u> 400,000 AstraZeneca doses to the country
Government Measures	Economic	 Labor Ministry <u>extended</u> the Repro II Program. This is an assistance program provided to companies for the payment of salaries in the context of emergency due to the pandemic. Argentina <u>receives</u> USD 4355 million from the IMF. It is an economic assistance granted by the Fund for the pandemic. Government will use these funds to pay maturities with international organizations.
	Country Opening	 Government <u>authorizes</u> an 80% capacity limit on buses and long-distance trains. Social, cultural and artistic events with a capacity of 70% and up to 1,000 people were <u>authorized</u> in the Province of Buenos Aires. This does not apply to sporting events.
Outlook	Political	 President Fernandez held a meeting with all his ministers. According to the <u>Chief of Staff</u>, they discussed management and political guidelines as well as about the campaign strategy for the next elections. The next <u>National Census</u> will be in May 2022 and may be completed online for the first time.
	Economic	According to <u>INDEC</u> , wholesale prices increased 2.2% in July. It was the lowest increase in the last 14 months.

	Health	Vaccination campaign for other infectious diseases beyond COVID-19 was <u>announced</u> by the Ministry of Health.
Government Measures	Vaccine Rollout	 Evaluations will be <u>carried out</u> in each department of the country to establish how vaccine rollout is taking place. It is important to consider that the vaccination campaign strategy has been enforced both by the local and national government. While urban municipalities have vaccinated rapidly, rural areas are still facing challenges. Over 300,000 Sputnik V vaccines to <u>arrive</u> this week in the country to reinforce second dose completion.
Measures	Economic	 Bolivian government to <u>invest</u> BOB \$7,000 million in construction, rehabilitation and road conservation. More than 65 local companies are participating throughout the process of implementation. President Luis Arce <u>inaugurated</u> the Industrial and Economic Recovery Summit in the city of Tarija. Working tables and spaces of discussion will take place jointly with business leaders and social organizations.
Outlook Political		 Questions <u>rise</u> after Evo Morales's trip to Peru last week. While Morales argued that the trip was financed with his personal savings, opposition leaders argued that it had been backed with public funds. United Nations' deputy head of human rights in Bolivia <u>warned</u> about the delicate health condition of former president Jeanine Añez after a personal interview made last week by the UN. While international pressures to clarify Añez's case increased, after an event <u>considered</u> by the police as an attempted suicide.

	Health	 Over the past week, Brazil <u>recorded</u> the fewest deaths from COVID-19 in 2021. ANVISA <u>authorized</u> a clinical study for the use of the monoclonal antibody leronlimab in the treatment of COVID-19 patients.
Government Measures	Vaccine Rollout	 The Pandemic CPI will hear testimony from Roberto Pereira Ramos Júnior, President of the FIB Bank, and Francisco de Araújo Filho, former Health Secretary of the Federal District, regarding the irregularities in vaccine purchases. The vaccination campaign is now reaching adolescents between the ages of 12 and 15, with São Paulo currently vaccinating those at increased risk within the age group.
Outlook	Political	 Conflict between the Executive and the Judiciary led Bolsonaro to introduce an impeachment request for Supreme Court Minister Alexandre de Moraes, and also delayed the confirmation of André Mendonça to the Court. The withdrawal of PL 2,337/2021, the Income Tax Reform, from the House floor agenda demonstrated the Executive's weakened governing position going forward with Bolsonaro's high disapproval ratings making negotiations with the legislative base more difficult.
	Economic	 President Bolsonaro approved the 2022 Budgetary Guidelines Law (LDO 2022) but vetoed the controversial R\$ 5.7 billion Electoral Fund, setting up a source of future tension with Congress. The economic recovery is being hampered by a worsening global scenario and Brazil's lack of a post-pandemic plan for the economy, with declining commodity prices and rising inflation

	Health	 Government and universities to <u>begin</u> research in how the COVID-19 disease expanded in elderly public homes. Ministry of Health <u>confirmed</u> first Delta case in the Magallanes Region.
Government Measures	Vaccine Rollout	 More than one million Sinovac vaccines <u>arrived</u> in the country as new updates on the immunization calendar were announced. New shipment of Pfizer-BioNTech vaccines <u>arrives</u> in Chile. With this, the country exceeds over 30 million doses that have entered the country since the start of the vaccination campaign.
	Country Opening	No commune has <u>entered</u> a quarantine as of last week.
Outlook	Political	 A bill that <u>seeks</u> to bring voting centers closer to voters' residences was unanimously approved in both chambers at Congress. The government <u>approved</u> two bills on Tuesday that seeks to improve human resources within the private sector and reinforce corporate governance in private companies. Yasna Provoste <u>jumps into</u> Chile's presidential race after winning the primary elections with more than 62% of the votes. Provoste is so far the only woman candidate running for November's presidential elections.
	Economic	 President Piñera <u>valued</u> the country's growth during the second quarter of the year. According to a report from the Central Bank, Chile is the eighth OECD country that has reached pre-pandemic production levels out of 46 countries evaluated.

	Political	 President Duque <u>traveled</u> to South Korea to reinforce the bilateral agenda on vaccine management, science, and technology. Outlook	Social	• The Strike Committee <u>calls</u> for new demonstrations in capital cities for August 26 th . While marches are organized against the new tax reform, smaller protests are expected compared to what was seen months ago.
	Economic	 The government emphasized on ISA's purchase by Colombia's majority state owned oil company Ecopetrol. According to Duque, the company becomes the main energy conglomerate in Latin America. According to Camacol, between January and July 2021, 133,419 homes were acquired in the country, representing an increase of 38.2% compared to the same period in 2020.


