



Vehicle Sizes: A Guide to Driving With Dispatch

Car

2 or 4 Door Sedan

Most items can fit in the front seat. This includes items like paint cans and supplies, AC and plumbing parts, small automotive parts, tools, a box of tiles, small signage, cleaning supplies, and documents.



Mid Sized

SUV, Crossover, and Minivan

Mid sized vehicles can hold similar items to cars, but in larger quantities. This includes items like five-gallon buckets of paint and larger signage.



Pickup Truck

Open or Closed Truck Bed

Pickup trucks can hold the same items as cars and mid sized vehicles but in larger quantities. Customers usually use this option for taller or longer items. This includes AC units, appliances, pipes, lumber, and ladders. Truck bed length should be a minimum of 78 inches.



Cargo Van

Classified Cargo Van

As the largest vehicle size, cargo vans can hold the same items listed previously, but larger quantities. This includes 5x10 signage, tables, lighting, spray and cleaning machines, and drywall. At a minimum, cargo vans have to fit a 4x8 pallet.
