Answer Key

All Saints Day

We celebrate all those who have died and reached heaven. This includes named saints of the Church and all those who are not named but with God.

1st reading: Revelation, New Testament (last book of the Bible)

2nd reading: 1 John

Gospel Matthew, The Beatitudes

Note: All Souls Day is when we remember everyone who has died and is not yet in heaven. All Souls Day is not a Holy Day of Obligation.

All Saints Day is a Holy Day of Obligation but since this year it is on Sunday there is no need to go to Mass another day.
