Today we celebrate an important feast in our Church's calendar, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. The Priest at your Church will wear either gold or white vestments to show what a special day this is! It's the last Sunday of our Church's year - next Sunday we begin the season of Advent and a whole new liturgical year!

Today we focus on the triumph of our Savior Jesus Christ. The Gospel this week reminds us about the end of Jesus' ministry on earth. Here he offers forgiveness and salvation to the criminal who recognizes Jesus and begs his forgiveness. Jesus, despite his own circumstance shines mercy and hope to this man seeking it - just as Jesus offers us mercy and hope and our salvation when we take time to acknowledge Him as our Lord and Savior!

- ★ Think about finding a special place in your home that's warm and inviting - take time each day this week to just invite Jesus to sit with you. Close your eyes and imagine him right next to you! Breathe in and out - and simply say, "Jesus, I Trust in You."
