#### Answers:

Liturgical season of Advent; priest is wearing purple; wreath has 4 candles (sometimes there are 5, one n the middle) Colors are usually 3 purple and 1 pink; sometimes they are blue or white with colored ribbon. 1 purple candle should be lit this week.

Readings: Isaiah, Ps 80, 1 Corinthians, Gospel of Mark

Rosary: Annunciation is when the angel Gabriel announced to Mary she would bear Jesus. Her actions differ from Eve in that she trusted and obeyed God, gave her yes, her "fiat" to be the mother of Jesus. Her yes brings new life into the world while Eve's yes brought sin and death into the world. Mary is the new Eve. This comes from Luke 1:26-38.
