needed. Marriage is normally only received once in a person's lifetime, but there are exceptions.



Answers:

Today we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord or the 7th Sunday of Easter. Ascension Thursday was moved to Sunday in the U.S. in all dioceses except: Boston, Hartford, New York, Newark, Omaha, and Philadelphia.

Readings: Acts, Eph, Mark (All in the New Testament)

Peter was the 1st Pope, Francis is our current Pope

The Pope lives Vatican City, which is in Rome, Italy.

The Ascension is celebrating Jesus ascending into heaven; the Assumption is Mary being taken up or assumed into heaven.
