Answers

Today is the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity

We believe in 1 God, 3 persons, God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit

Prayer is the Sign of the Cross, also the Glory Be

Readings: 1st - Deuteronomy, Moses is talking, telling the people to follow the commandments and that there is no one greater than God

2nd-Romans, yes everyone can receive the gift of the Holy Spirit; through the sacraments, especially Baptism and Confirmation as well as through prayer

Gospel -Matthew; Jesus is telling the apostles to go out into the world, make disciples and tell the good news and to baptize; after that he ascends into heaven
