Building a Prioritisation model gave the team the ability to align and to create a structured rational approach that empowered them to challenge low value projects



Promote Transparent Project Prioritization
Engage Stakeholders in Project Scoring

Score Project Requests
In a periodic basis, stakeholders score the projects against the criteria

Collect and Aggregate Votes
An online tool generates questionnaires, automates the collection of votes and aggregates results into a visual format
