

Dear student,

Our institution has been following and monitoring very closely the situation and preventive measures of COVID-19, adopted by the Government during this difficult phase in which we find ourselves. Thus, and according to the recent decision of the Council of Ministers, we will maintain the regime hitherto followed, combining face-to-face, rotating and distance learning classes.

As planned and communicated at the beginning of the academic year, **the classes will remain operational through the academic model *Experiential Learning Hyflex***, implemented this year and which allows us to more efficiently manage the challenges imposed, as well as the evaluation period.

In this sense, the face-to-face assessment will remain without any changes, except for students at risk, in confinement by positive test for COVID-19 or in prophylactic confinement, as indicated by the competent authorities or at the recommendation of our institution. For these students, assessments of the normal and resource periods will be carried out in a distance format, as we have already shared in previous communications.

We also inform that the Academic Services, Libraries and Study Rooms remain open on the campuses. The International and Employability Offices will only be available remotely (via telephone and / or email). The reprography services will be closed and the cafeteria will operate only on a take-away basis.

We also remember that whenever you come to the campus you must be accompanied by the declaration of displacement previously sent.

We remind you that the use of a mask is mandatory, also in all exterior spaces of our institution, and that you must maintain a careful respiratory etiquette, regular disinfection of the hands, and comply with physical distance. Universidade Europeia contingency plan can be consulted [here](#).
