POSITION OBJECTIVE: Use leadership, supervisory and teaching skills to promote the development of the individual program and student-athletes. To teach and promote the glorification of God, through the pursuit of excellence in athletics.

QUALIFICATIONS: HS diploma required, with a Bachelor's degree preferred; a combination of playing experience at the collegiate level and/or three to four years of coaching experience at the high school level is preferred. Prior to the start of the season, all coaches must meet the CSLA Coaches Certification requirements that include:

- First Aid/CPR
- Heat Acclimatization and Heat Illness prevention training
- Performance enhancing drugs training
- Concussion management training

- Exceptional interpersonal skills
- Appropriate knowledge of their sport

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The head coach has full responsibility for supervision of the program, including sub-varsity, and varsity teams. All Varsity coaches are encouraged to work with the Grade and Middle school teams to assist in building the overall program.
- Teaches skills necessary for excellent achievement.
- Conducts sports program according to knowledge of physical growth patterns and appropriate training methods for the age of the participants.
- Plans and schedules a practice schedule in conjunction with Director of Athletics.
- Maintains fair and consistent management and discipline of young athletes, making certain the participants and parents know and understand all athletics and individual sport expectations and all rules governing eligibility.
- Demonstrates a positive model for participants, that include exemplary sportsmanship, respect for opponents, and officials, and high personal moral values.
- Conducts the program in accordance with C.S. Lewis Academy's philosophy and mission of *"Preparing Students for Life"* as well as abiding by the district/conference adopted policies and rules of OSAA.
