Building on strong school relationships with families helps us build sustainability and trust outside of the school gates. Parents have confidence that their child will be engaged in a high-quality experience that will be safe, professional, and most importantly, fun. Reaching out into the community during school holidays, evenings and weekends, the opportunity to embed a love of physical activity outside of school is the first step toward healthy choices for many children and leading physically literate lives.

Community club offer

Once partnered with a local club we can signpost children and families to the clubs and can facilitate and support the transition from school to club before handing over to the club coaches. We can also partner with the clubs to deliver Holiday Camps and any additional community coaching such as Start Sporty 'tots' sessions to support a 'conveyor belt' approach of new participants each year.


