

Frequently Asked Questions About The 2020 National Red Ribbon Photo Contest

How Do | Enter?



- 1. Families can enter the contest by uploading a photo to www.redribbon.org/contest of their home front door, fence or mailbox decorated with a double-looped Red Ribbon and this year's National Red Ribbon Week Theme: Be Happy. Be Brave. Be Drua Free™.
- 2. School employees/PTA members can enter the contest by uploading a photo to www.redribbon.org/contest of their school or virtual school decoration, which must include a double-looped Red Ribbon and this year's National Red Ribbon Week Theme: Be Happy. Be Brave. Be Drug Free™.
 - * ONLY ONE ENTRY PER SCHOOL WILL BE ACCEPTED.

What Do We Need To Include In Our Photo Entry?

A Red Ribbon (a double-looped ribbon like a red bow you'd see on a gift) and this year's theme "Be Happy. Be Brave. Be Drug Free™." must be included in the photo.



For Home Decoration entries, the photo must be taken in front of a home front door, fence or mailbox decoration and must not be cropped.



For School/Virtual School Decoration entries, the photo must include a highly visible decoration such as the front of the school or feature aspects of the virtual school.



If you are including a photo of a virtual school environment, use your imagination when 🐐 displaying your online space. How can you best showcase the Red Ribbon Theme? You are welcome to Include people and themed items and imagery in your photo.







Can I Use Photoshop On My Entry?

No, photos must be of actual decorations. Photoshopped images will be disqualified.

How Can | Win?

- 1. Receive the most votes in your region for your entry (10 winners) during the voting period (November 2-16, 2020). Voting takes place at www.redribbon.org/vote
