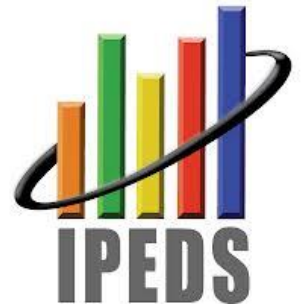

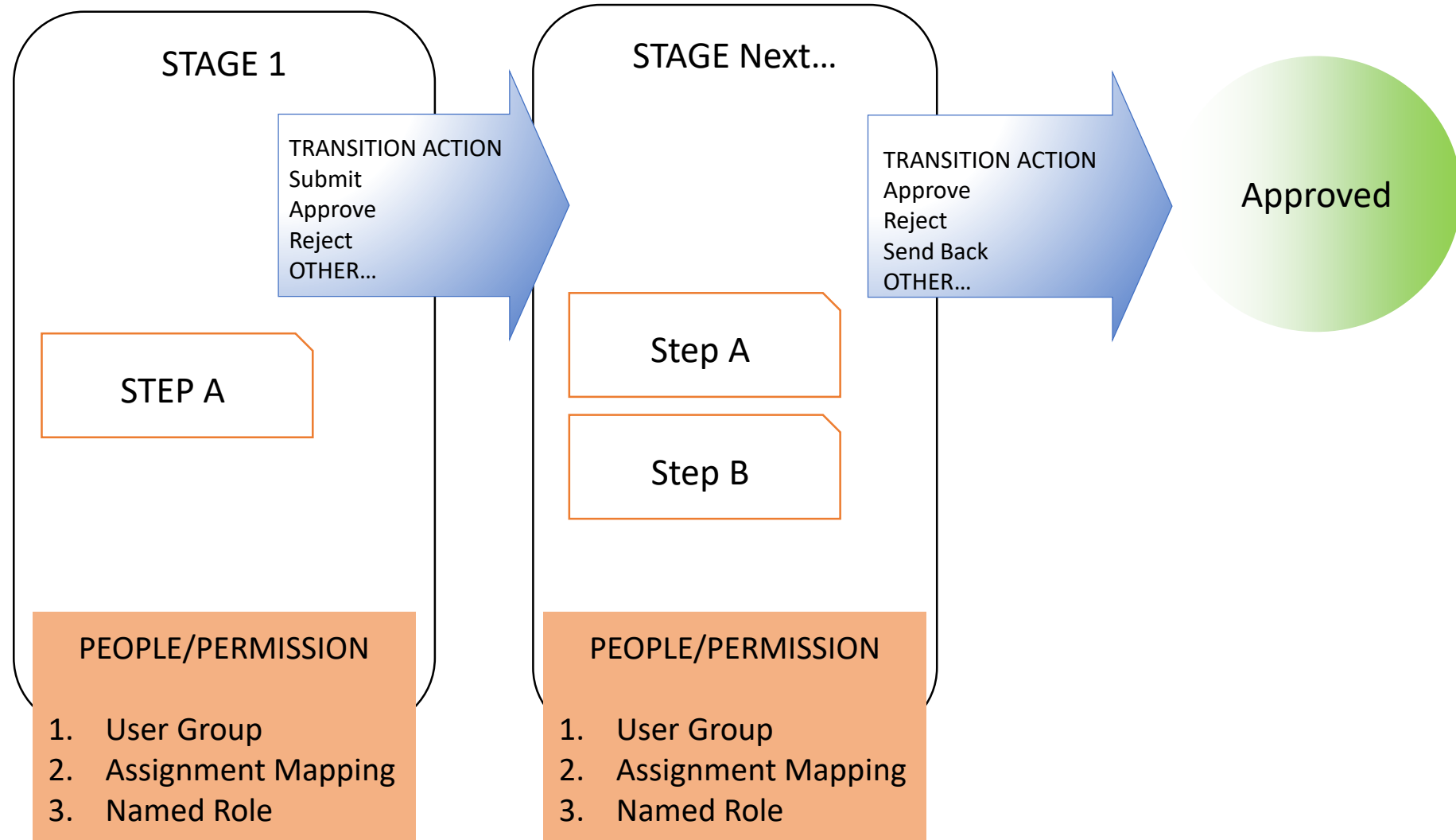

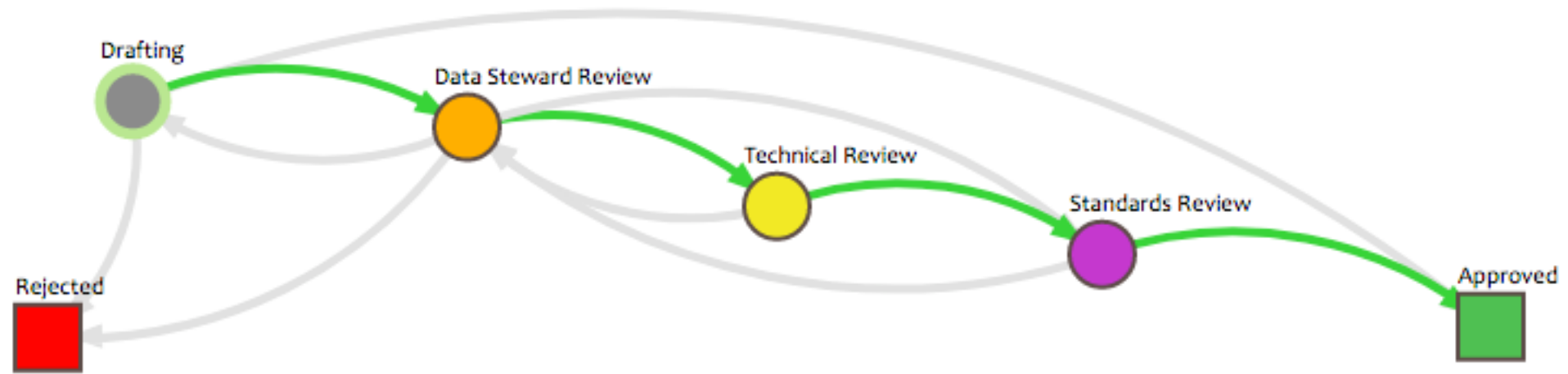
Illustrate

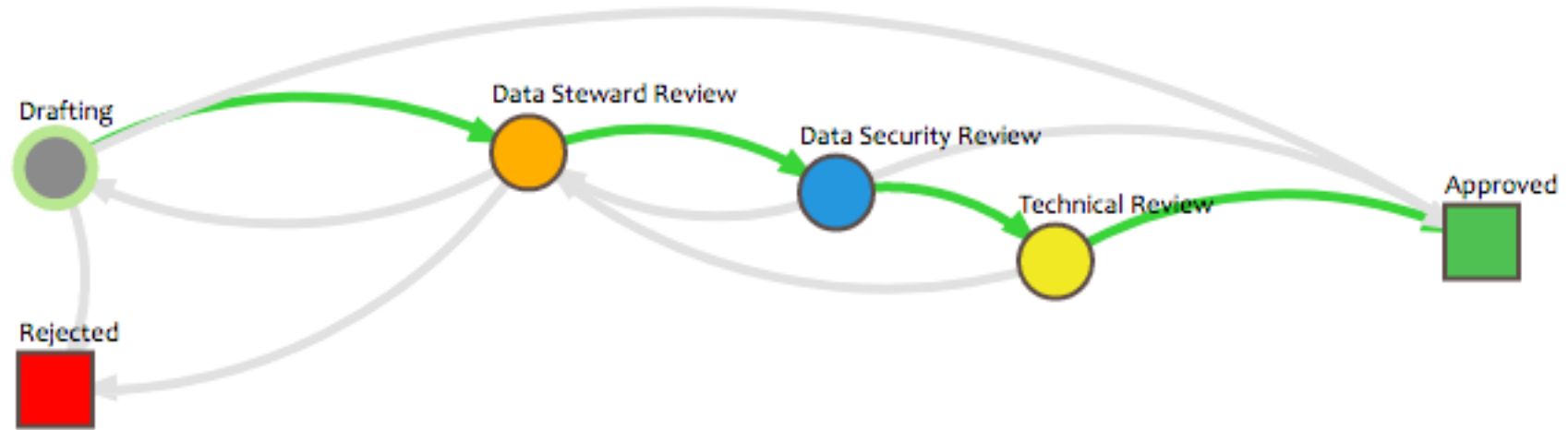


Tricky parts

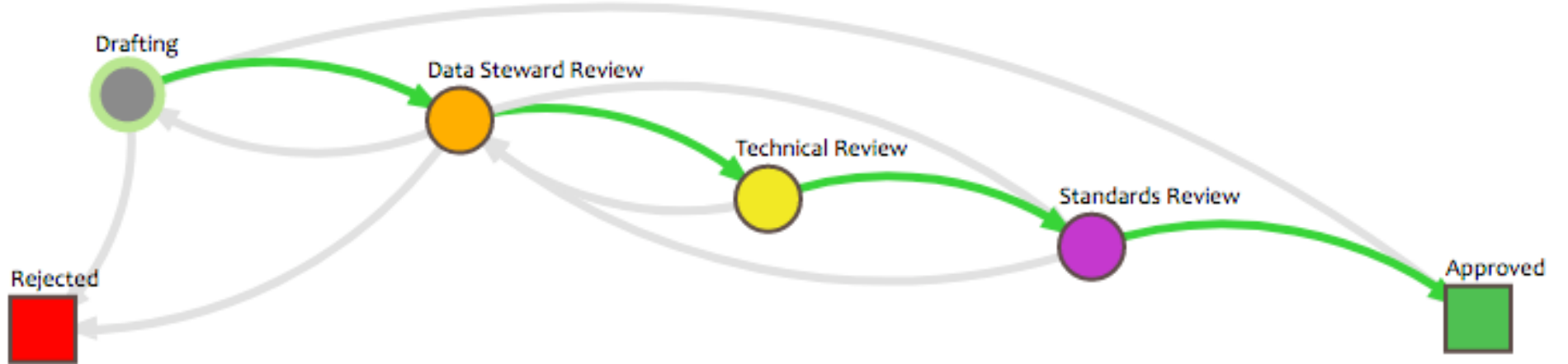
- Accommodate multiple Functional Areas (Assignment mapping)
- Must enter Technical definition prior to Technical Review or Leap Frog alternative path
- Populate Assignment Mappings with General user groups
- Multiple steps per Stage
- Courtesy Entry Point for Approval by data steward at Drafting

Primary and Conditional Bundle

HR only



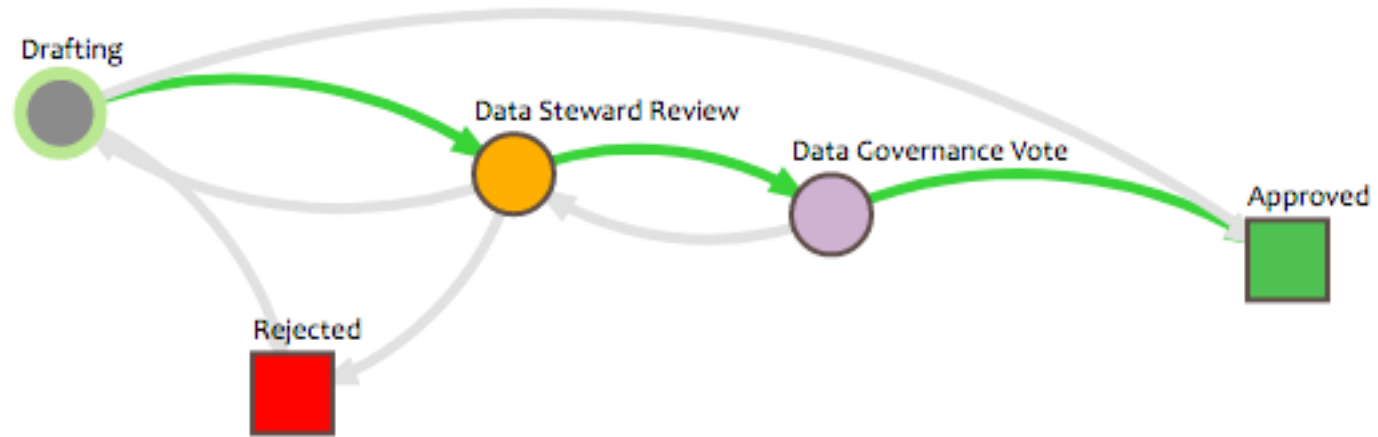

Tricky parts – Primary and Conditional Bundle

- HR workflow
 - Conditional on a workflow
 - Accommodate multiple Functional Areas (HR and xyz) (Assignment mapping)
- Both workflows
 - Order on workflow display page

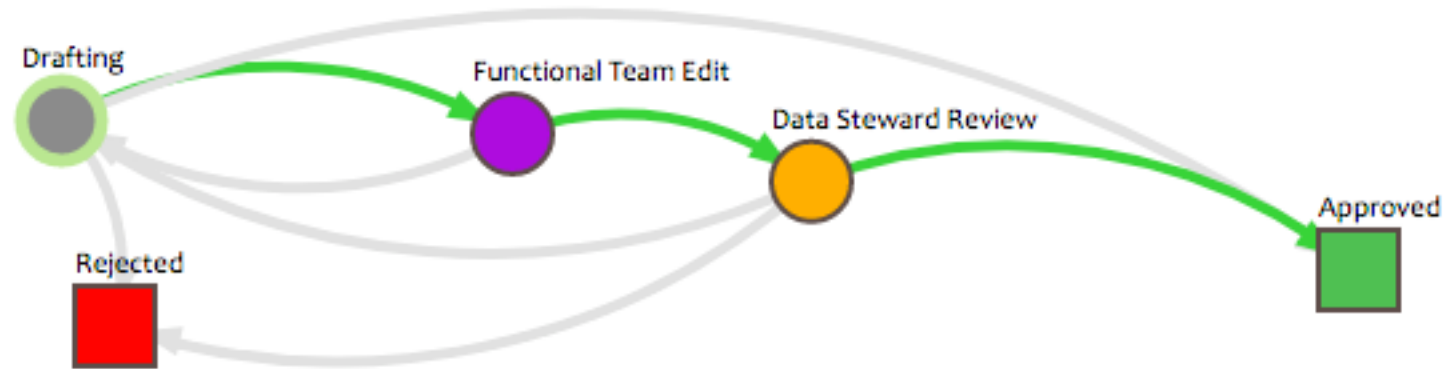
Vote



Tricky parts - Vote

- Data Governance Stage
 - All
 - No timeout
 - Override in Approve transition action
 - Not allowed to Edit or Collaborate

Functional Team Edits



Tricky Parts – Functional Team Editing

- Assignment Mapping – Editors by Functional Area
 - Use of “General Editors” group in Mapping
- Required | All
- 3 Day Timeout balances the Required | All

Advanced Features

- Alternate Paths
 - Send back | Leap frog
 - Override
- Entry Point (jump to later stage from Create a Definition)
- Multiple steps per Stage
- Conditional
 - Functional Area
 - Data System
 - Classification Code

Migrating to a new workflow

- Definitions stay within the workflow in use when Definition was created
- 2 methods to migrate
 1. Prior to installing the new workflow, approve all definitions in the current workflow, then Version the definitions that need the new workflow.
 2. Export all definitions, then delete them. Install the new workflow, then import definitions.
- Not required to migrate – do nothing
 - Confusion in both directions
 - Content “falsely” approved
 - Staff using 2 workflows simultaneously

Versions

- Tasks that force a new version
 - New Stage
 - New Step
 - Change All/Any within a Step
 - Change Entry Point or Override within a Transition Action
 - Conditional
- Tasks that do NOT force a new version
 - Change labels or descriptions
 - Check/Uncheck Required
 - Create new Transition Actions or edit existing
 - Swap User Groups, Assignment Mapping, or Named Role
 - Change users within user groups
