

Document	Last Updated	Description
<u>User's Guide</u>	11/19/2019	Reference documentation for users of the Data Cookbook. The users guide includes descriptions of workflows and feature.
Administrator's Guide	09/18/2019	Reference documentation for administrators of the Data Cookbook. The admin guide includes information on configuring the account as well as managing permissions and designing worfklows.
External Authentication	08/21/2019	The Data Cookbook allows organizations to authenticate users through their existing authentication repositories. Currently it supports LDAP, Active Directory, CAS and Shibboleth protocols. This document provides details for administrators on configuring external authentication for your organization.
Test Instances	08/21/2019	Reference documentation for administrators and users who are working in the Test Instance of the Data Cookbook.
Metrics Dashboard	11/19/2019	Reference documentation for users for working with the Metrics Dashboard feature, which provides insights into your organization's usage of the Data Cookbook.
Private Community User's Guide	08/21/2019	Reference documentation for users who have access to a private community. This guide should be used in conjunction with the Data Cookbook User's Guide

Steps

- 1. Check Permissions
 - a. Admin Automatically Approve
 - b. Manager
 - c. Editor
- 2. Prepare file using Import Template
- 3. Preview
- 4. Fix Errors
- 5. Accept and Import

Fundamentals – Demo import new definitions

- Login as John Admin and import 10 definitions
 - Spoiler Alert Use corrupted file first to show errors
 - Note duplicate in yellow
 - Wiki links for existing definitions are made
 - Missing Definition links are made if new

Detailed look at Import Templates

- Display visual
- Picky
- View in text editor to catch hidden characters
- Add additional Technical Definitions 3 columns
- Download file; sample file

Permissions

- Editor
- Manager
- Administrator

Use Cases

- 1. Import new
- 2. Import new, unaware of a duplicate
- 3. Export / Import
 - a. Bulk edits
 - b. Utilize new workflow
 - c. Add technical definitions

Overwrite or Not

Definition	Overwrite	Do Not Overwrite
Approved	New version; edits reflected	New version
In Progress	Edits reflected	No change
HTML format Approved	New version; lose HTML; edits reflected	New version; format preserved
HTML format In Progress	Edits reflected; lose HTML	No change
Quality Attribute Approved	New version; edits reflected; Quality not preserved	New version; Quality not preserved
Quality Attribute In Progress	Changes reflected; lose Quality in prior and new versions; edits reflected	No change

Overwrite or Not

Definition	Overwrite	Do Not Overwrite
Approved (Actual Financial Aid)	New version; edits reflected	New version
In Progress (Academic Advisor)	Edits reflected	No change
HTML format Approved (Academic Rank)	New version; lose HTML in prior and new versions; edits reflected	New version; format preserved
HTML format In Progress (Academic Calendar)	Edits reflected; lose HTML	No change
Quality Attribute Approved (Admit Type)	New version; edits reflected	New version; Quality not preserved
Quality Attribute In Progress (Academic Division)	Changes reflected; lose Quality in prior and new versions; edits reflected	No change

Summary: Use Do Not Overwrite when you want to version duplicates in bulk. Use Overwrite to commit global edits. What is more work – replacing HTML or Quality Attributes, or manually editing 150 definitions?

Summary


- Use the Import Template
