

<u>User's Guide</u>	06/23/2020	Reference documentation for users of the Data Cookbook. The users guide includes descriptions of workflows and feature.
Administrator's Guide	06/23/2020	Reference documentation for administrators of the Data Cookbook. The admin guide includes information on configuring the account as well as managing permissions and designing worfklows.
External Authentication	08/21/2019	The Data Cookbook allows organizations to authenticate users through their existing authentication repositories. Currently it supports LDAP, Active Directory, CAS and Shibboleth protocols. This document provides details for administrators on configuring external authentication for your organization.
<u>Test Instances</u>	08/21/2019	Reference documentation for administrators and users who are working in the Test Instance of the Data Cookbook.
<u>Metrics Dashboard</u>	11/19/2019	Reference documentation for users for working with the Metrics Dashboard feature, which provides insights into your organization's usage of the Data Cookbook.
Private Community User's Guide	08/21/2019	Reference documentation for users who have access to a private community. This guide should be used in conjunction with the Data Cookbook User's Guide



1. Manage Tags

- Key Review
 - Assigned to definitions and specifications
 - Browse filter
 - Added at object and at master list
- View Tag list
- Delete outdated tags
 - From object
 - From master list only if tag originally created through an object
- Communicate a Usage Policy
 - See Help Text

2. Manage Missing Definitions

- Key review (see definition Meal Plan)
 - Create a wiki link within a functional definition to a word or phrase that has not been created yet; it's a placeholder. To view: select Missing Definitions on Definition menu
- Monitor for age; sort by Create Date
- Complete or Delete
- Definitions can be approved with placeholders still active. See definition Complete Online Course

3. Manage URLs embedded within Definitions

Key review

- URLs may be embedded in any text box.
- Points to additional information published internally or externally
- See definition Visa Classification

• Process:

- Use systematic preface: See URL: https://blah.blah
- Schedule review quarterly, semiannually, etc
- Keyword search all text boxes per schedule

4. Report on your account via ODBC


- Key Review
 - Request it
 - Use your own reporting tool
- 15 views documented as Specifications in Community
- 5 Sample views:
 - 1. User activity: views
 - 2. Custom fields: usage
 - 3. Definition comments
 - 4. Which definitions and specifications undergo multiple versions
 - 5. View all open Tasks

5. Identify objects stuck within workflows

- Key Review
 - Queue
 - Filter rows
 - Uncheck Available for action by me
- Filter by workflow stage
 - Definition > Workflow with tech def > Data steward review
- Filter by Originator
- Sort Date Started (simple)

6. Use a Standards Review stage in every workflow

- Maintain editorial control
- Maintain correct usage



7. Use a Step in some Stages for a Content Manager

- Key review
 - Courtesy step; without a step, a user cannot act
- Convenient to nudge

Monitor Data Stewards	A convenience step that allows the Data Cookbook content manager to edit and approve all definitions. These actions are taken when data stewards are unavailable.	no	no	any	Edit	0	Approve Reject Back to drafting		<u>Content</u> <u>Manager</u>	edit x

8. Designate a Content Manger

- Neutral party who maintains editorial and usage standards
 - Editorial: wiki links; vacuous text; grammar; spelling; title case
 - Usage standards: Spec type is used consistently; Tags are used correctly
- .25 or .5 FTE


- Practice some or all of these items
- Content Manager or Data Steward as actor
- Document what is done
- Use documentation as marketing material
