# 2) Register With the FAA

1. Follow this Link: <https://iacra.faa.gov/IACRA/Default.aspx>
2. Click "Register" and follow the steps/fill out your information
  - Role: Applicant
3. You will receive an FTN number, use that number to register for a test

### 3) Register With Testing Facility

1. Follow this link: <https://faa.psiexams.com/faa/login>
  - a. This link applies to Tyler, Texas testing. Testing information for other cities can be found once you log in to the [iacra.faa.gov](https://iacra.faa.gov) website in the instructions above.
2. “Register” and follow the steps/fill out your information

### 4) Schedule Your Test

1. Follow this link: <https://faa.psiexams.com/faa/login>
2. Login
3. Select Exam: Unmanned Aircraft General – Small (UAG)
  - Number of Exam Attempts: 1
  - Authorization Category: None
4. Pay for test using company card, if you do not have a company card, get with your manager to arrange for payment
  - The company will pay for your first test, follow up testing due to failure will be handled on a case-by-case basis
5. Record test facility address and add to your calendar!

### 5) Take Your Test

1. Arrive ten minutes early
2. Bring your ID, the facility will provide all other necessary materials
3. Keep the “Test Report” the facility gives you after your test

### 6) Apply for Your License

You passed! Now you need to apply for your license.

1. Follow this link: <https://iacra.faa.gov/IACRA/Default.aspx>
2. Login
3. Click “Start New Application”

4. Enter your info (\*Leave "Airman Certificate Number" and "Date of Issuance" blank)
  - a. Application Type: Pilot
  - b. Certifications: Remote Pilot – Initial
