T.M. SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility

- An Australian citizens or permanent residents
- Have attended the Summer or Winter School Holiday Workshop Series
- Complete and pass the LLN and Pre Training Review (VET Courses only)
- Complete entry requirements

Terms & Conditions

- The Scholarship recipient can only use the scholarship for tuition on the course specified on their offer
- If the student does not complete the course they will be required to pay for the studies they have undertaken
- Students must attend class regularly and pass all course assessments or risk losing scholarship funding
- The student agrees to be a Student Ambassador as part of T.M. Elite
- The scholarship does not cover the cost of materials and equipment. Students are required to purchase their materials kits (applies to VET courses)
