Air Canada	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Whatever Altitude status you currently hold in 2020, you will be automatically extended through the end of 2021. If you were to reach a higher status before the end of this year, you'll enjoy it upon qualification and through 2021 as well. If you have already achieved Altitude status for next year, or if you do by the end of 2020, you can gift that status to a friend or loved one. You will now have 18 months to keep your account active, six months longer than before.
Alaska Air Lines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your current Mileage Plan status will be extended through December 31, 2021. The elite-qualifying miles you've earned January 2020-April 2020 will be rolled into 2021 to give you a head start on earning status for 2022. Extending the current 50% bonus offer to earn elite-qualifying miles with no registration, June 1 – December 31, 2020.
American Airlines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Extending elite status for AAdvantage members until January 31, 2022. Reducing elite status qualification for 2020. Extending Admiral Club memberships purchased from American for 6 months. Every dollar spent on an eligible AAdvantage co-branded credit card through the end of 2020 will count for one mile toward Million Miler status.
Avianca	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All members who earned an Elite status requirement in 2019 and received in on March 1, 2020, will have their status extended until January 31, 2022. The LifeMiles rating system was reduced by 50%. The expiration of those miles that were scheduled between April 1 and December 30, 2020 will be automatically paused.
British Airways	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> BA is lowering Tier Point threshold by 25% for all members. BA is adding 12 months extra onto your Executive Club membership. All members will benefit, starting with those who have a Tier Point collection end date of July 2020. Through June 2021.
Cathay Pacific	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Granting members bonus points to help make up for lost travel. These will be granted in monthly increments to Marco Polo Club members and represent on a portion of the points.
Delta Air Lines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Medallion Members will be able to enjoy their current Status through 2021. All Medallion Qualifications Miles from 2020 are being rolled over to 2021 to qualify for 2022 Medallion Status. Delta Sky Club Individual and Executive memberships with an expiration of March 1, 2020, or later will receive six additional months of Delta Sky Club access beyond their expiration date. SkyMiles Select members will receive a six-month extension to the Priority Boarding benefit and any unused drink vouchers.
Emirates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Existing Emirates Skywards Silver, Gold and Platinum members can requalify for status by meeting 80% of the travel requirements for their respective status tier this year. All flights completed before January 30, 2020 will receive 20% more Tier Miles towards status qualification.
Etihad Airways	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Etihad Airways announced that beginning March 31, 2020, it will distribute bonus Tier Miles to all Etihad Guest members on a monthly basis in order to help them maintain elite status. Etihad is offering double tier points on all trips taken between March 1 and June 30, 2020.
Flying Blue	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will maintain all Flying Blue Elite members with a qualification period ending between March 2020 and February 2021 for another 12 months.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will prevent all Miles from expiring between now and the end of 2020 for all Explorer members.
Hainan Airlines and Hong Kong Airlines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fortune Wings, the loyalty program used by Hainan Airlines, Hong Kong Airlines and other Chinese carriers has automatically extended elite status validity for elite members. Elite status members who are set to lose their current elite status tier will have their elite status extended for up to 14 months.
Hawaiian Airlines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Elite members at Hawaiian Airlines have had their status extended through February 2022. Qualifications to achieve elite status have been reduced by 50% for 2021. No miles will expire through December 31.
JetBlue	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All current Mosaic members will have their travel perks extended through the end of 2021. This applies to all Mosaic members with status set to expire on December 31, 2020. JetBlue has reduced Mosaic requirements by 50% for this year.
LATAM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> LATAM has extended status validity for all LATAM Pass elite members through March 2022.
Qantas Airways	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Qantas will be applying an automatic 12-month extension to the membership tier status for eligible Qantas Frequent Flyers
Qatar Airways	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Qatar is extending or giving back status to all members with status set to expire before January 31, 2021. The status will be extended for an additional year.
Singapore Airlines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Singapore Airlines announced that they will be automatically renewing all KrisFlyer Elite and PPS Club membership statuses for another 12 months at the end of their membership year. The validity of any expiring PPS and Elite Gold rewards will be extended until March 31, 2021.
Southwest Airlines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For Companion Pass holders who earned benefits through December 31, 2020, Southwest is extending your current benefits through June 30, 2021. For A-List and A-List Preferred Members who earned this status will be extending your status through December 31, 2021. Southwest is making it easier for Rapid Rewards Members to earn tier status and Companion Pass this year by giving everyone 15,000 tier qualifying points. Southwest will prevent all Miles from expiring between now and the end of 2022 for all Explorer members.
TAP Portugal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> TAP Portugal has extended elite status for some elite status members by 12 months. Extending mileage validity by a year and offering bonus miles to TAP Miles&Go members.
Turkish Airlines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Turkish Airlines is extending statuses for six months beyond current expiration date.
United Air Lines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you have current 2020 Premier status, it will be extended to January 31, 2022. At a minimum, you will enjoy the same published status next year that you have today. For the 2021 status year, United is reducing thresholds for Premier qualification by 50% for each status level, to make reaching an even higher tier easier. Six-month extension of any PlusPoints set to expire on or before January 31, 2021.
Virgin Atlantic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Virgin Atlantic will be extending the status for all the Silver and Gold members by 6 months. Gold members who have earned a companion reward for renewing Gold status, Clubhouse passes for the 1500 tier point reward of the 2000 tier point upgrade reward will have these rewards extended by six months.
WestJet	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> WestJet is extending the validity on unredeemed companion vouchers expiring in March, April, or May 2020 and companion vouchers with an earlier expiry date, that were redeemed for travel between March 1 and June 30, 2020 where travel was canceled due to COVID-19. Extended or upgrade members who were on track to achieve status in March, April or May will continue to look after those whose tier status may be impacted in the months ahead.

Accor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All Accor Live Limitless (ALL) tiers of status will be extended an additional year for all members residing in Greater China, including the mainland, Hong Kong, Macau, and Taiwan. These statuses will now expire December 31, 2021, regardless of how many eligible nights a member completes in 2020.
Best Western	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reward members around the globe to maintain their current status through January 31, 2022. Members were downgraded a tier at the end of 2019 were leveled-up to their previous tier and will maintain that status through January 31, 2022 without needing to fulfill the necessary qualifications. Status will be maintained for all members regardless of their current tier, ensuring both new and veteran members are protected.
Choice Hotels	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Extended all members' current elite status through December 31, 2021, regardless of the number of nights you stay this year. Points expiration has been paused until December 31, 2020.
Hilton	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All members whose 2019 status was scheduled to be downgraded on March 31, 2020 will automatically receive an extension through March 31, 2021. Hilton is extending 2020-member status through March 31, 2022. This means you will continue to enjoy all the Diamond, Gold or Silver benefits you have access to today for the next 24 months. All points scheduled to expire between now and December 31, 2020 will be paused.
Hyatt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hyatt has sweetened the pot for point users, with a 15% rebate for general members and a 25% rebate for World of Hyatt Credit cardholders on point redeemed for stays through January 24, 2021. Registration required by December 1, 2020. Status and benefits will be extended for all existing elite members without having to re-qualify. This means that whatever your status was as of March 31, 2020 will automatically updated to reflect a February 28, 2022 expiration date.
IHG	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All members' program status earned in 2019 will be extended through January 2022. For Spire Elite members this includes Choice benefit of 25,000 bonus points or gifting of Platinum Elite status to someone each year. IHG Rewards is reducing Elite membership criteria required this year by 25% or more.
Marriott	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Members received an extension of their earned Elite Status through February 2022. Members who have been inactive for at least 24 months and have points expiring prior to February 1, 2021 will have their points expiration date automatically extended to February 1, 2021. Members who earned Elite Status in 2019 will receive a one-time deposit of 50% of their tier's annual Elite Night Credit requirement.
Omni Hotels & Resorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For members who did not re-achieve their Platinum or Black Level status last year: We did not process downgrades at the end of February. We extended status through the end of 2020. For members who earned or re-achieved status in 2019: We extended status through the end of 2021.
Preferred Hotels & Resorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The I Prefer reward program announced that all elite members will retain their status through June 31, 2021, regardless of the number of nights they complete this year. Extending points expiration for all members through August 31, 2020.
Radisson Hotels	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Has extended elite status through February 2022 for members who would have expired in February 2021. Suspended its points expiration for six months, starting March 1, 2020. Travelers with e-certs that are set to expire through June 30, 2020 will now be able to redeem them for stays through June 30, 2021.
Shangri-La Hotels and Resorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Extending all Golden Circle tier status members (Diamond and Jade) around the globe through December 31, 2021.
Wyndham Hotels	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pausing the expiration of any Wyndham Reward points until September 30, 2020 and have extended current Wyndham Rewards Members Levels (status) for all members globally through the end of 2021.

Agency	Remarks
Avis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Automatically extended their current Avis Preferred status through January 15, 2022, regardless of their 2020 rental activity. This applies to all Avis Preferred status – Avis Preferred Plus, President’s Club, and Chairman’s club.
Budget	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Budget does not have an award points and elite status to its members, but members can earn \$25 Budget Bucks every 2 rentals. Normally Budget Bucks expire after 12 months.
Enterprise	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Current Enterprise Plus elite members will receive a one-year status extension. If you are a Silver, Gold or Platinum level member with a tier expiration date of 2/28/2021, your current status will be extended through February 28, 2022. Also rolling over elite qualifying rentals and rental days.
Hertz	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hertz has extended their current loyalty status through January 31, 2022. Members with points that were set to expire between March 13 and June 30, 2020, have the opportunity to claim them.
National	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Current Emerald Club Executive and Executive Elite members with tiers set to expire on February 28, 2021, will automatically receive a 1-year extension and keep their status through February 28, 2022. Qualifying rentals and rental days will rollover.
