### **RULES AND GUIDELINES**

- All entries must be submitted online; e-books must be provided at time of submission. Entries must be accompanied by the required entry fee by credit/debit card or PayPal. All entries must be in English.
- There is no cap as to the number of submissions or categories that can be entered into the competition overall, however each submission is limited to one book and category (per entry).
- Have your necessary information, including your e-book or, at hand when you are ready to submit your entry.
- Additional entry discounts are only available when using the linked entry form offered during submission of a full price entry. We cannot offer refunds for discounts not redeemed through the linked form.
- All submissions are final. Refunds are not provided for disqualified, withdrawn or non-winning entries. Once a submission has been checked out, it is entered into the competition and cannot with edited or replaced.
- If the Grand Prize Winner accepts the Writer's Digest Conference portion of their prize they must agree to travel (flying round-trip from the same city) during the conference dates in 2021. The editors or agents who meet with the Grand Prize Winner are under no obligation to read, buy or represent the Grand Prize Winner's work. This prize includes airfare, hotel and conference registration.

- All entries must be submitted online through Submittable. If you already have a Submittable account, simply log in!
- Please be sure that the email address that you provide will be valid throughout the competition span. Competition related updates and winner notifications are sent via: email. Please type carefully and list only one email address. Check your spelling carefully including all login information, email addresses etc. Incorrect email addresses may result in the transmission of important information being delayed and/or unsuccessful. Be sure that our email addresses (Writer's Digest and Submittable) are not blocked, or you may not receive critical information, receipts, confirmations etc. Check your SPAM folder for any expected but unaccounted for email communications.
- You must enter online and must provide either a file or a gifted copy of the book in true e-book form\*. \*A file of your book, published/readable in true e-book form-to be readable on computers or other electronic devices. E-books can be read on dedicated e-reader devices or computer that feature a controllable viewing screen. or submit your entry by using a gifting process such as Amazon.
- Acceptable file types include .epub, .mobi (PDFs, Microsoft Word documents and other word processing type documents (.doc, .docx, .odt, etc.) are not acceptable file types.) If submitting your book by using the Amazon gifting process, please follow the *Amazon Gifting Process* instructions provided in this packet. If you do not have the book file and cannot gift us a copy through Amazon, there is a space on the entry form where you can provide us instructions for obtaining a complimentary copy of your e-book. If selecting "Other" as your delivery method, please note that the book itself must be able to be accessed using a one-click link that provides immediate download and/or access to the book via: a code. Judges will not provide personal information of any sort, nor will they set up accounts, provide emails etc., nor can they retrieve a book using a gift certificate or anything of monetary value. If you are submitting a file; please follow the requirements for that delivery method.

- If gifting a copy of your book, please note that gift codes must be valid until through the entire competition-up to the winner notification date. iTunes gift codes have a particularly short redemption period, shorter than the duration of the competition. For this reason, books published through iTunes should be provided as a .mobi or .epub file instead).
- Additional files/books/codes may be requested of semi-finalists.
- Note to foreign entrants: If you do not live in the US and/or if the book is not available on a US Platform (i.e. (US) Amazon.com vs. (non-US) Amazon.ca), then the book may not be available to us due to copyright restrictions. In these cases, please provide an actual file of your entry at the time of submission, instead of providing a gift code.
- Please note that bait books (free e-books that drive the reader to a traceable-author or otherwise-email list) are not to be acceptable, as they put a judges' anonymity as risk.
- Do not provide your book using a method that would require anyone-including a judge, to enter personal information of any sort. Judges will not set up accounts, provide emails, etc. in order to retrieve/review a book. In addition, our judges cannot retrieve a book using a gift certificate, or anything of monetary value).

### LOG IN to your Amazon 1-Click account.

On your book's product page (be sure that you are selecting the Kindle version of the book), follow Amazon's gifting instructions under the BUY FOR OTHERS section. GIFT the book to yourself, listing your OWN email address as the recipient.

You (as the gift recipient) will then receive an email\* announcing that you've received the gift; the subject line will read: "Amazon.com: A Gift from [yourself]..."



\*Make sure that you are checking the same email address, as the one that you provided as the gift recipient email. If you use multiple email addresses with Amazon, you may need to check both.

**LOG OUT** of your Amazon account.

**CLICK ON '***Get your Kindle book gift now*'. You will be re-directed to the product page of the gifted copy of book. **DO NOT** 'Accept the Kindle book gift'; the link will not be useable by us if you do.

From the product/gift redemption page of the gifted book (once again, making sure that you are **LOGGED OUT** of your Amazon account), **COPY THE URL FROM YOUR BROWSER**, and paste it into your online submission form. (ex: "*https://www.amazon.com/gp/product/sample kindle-redemption.....*")

IMPORTANT: DO NOT forward the Amazon emails to the competition office. Links must be copy/pasted into the online submission form.

Typical length\*: 40,000 to 100,000 words. There are no limits for submissions; Novellas and Epics are all welcomed. Fantasy: High or urban, historical or alternate histories, introduce us to new worlds and fantastic ideas that exceed the boundaries of our own reality. Typical length\*: 40,000 to 100,000 words. Typical length\*: 40,000 to 100,000 words. There are no limits for submissions. Nonfiction: Journalists and subject-matter experts will find a home for their work in this category, which consists primarily of research-based works, as well as cookbooks, how-to/reference, self-help, business, etc. Typical length\*: 40,000 to 100,000 words. There are no limits for submissions.

Having troubles logging in? Competition submissions are collected using the online submission system SUBMITTABLES. For help using their system, and for payment related questions (during or after submission) go to: https://submittable.help/en/articles/923459-how-do-i-sign-in-to-my-submittable-account

Are there any restrictions regarding content, language, subject matter etc.? No, we do not have any restrictions or preferences. Competition entries must be submitted in English.

Are there word count requirements for this competition? No, this competition does not have any length or word count requirements.

Do you allow simultaneous submissions? Yes, simultaneous submissions are certainly allowed. Simply inform us of acceptance elsewhere, if applicable.

What are your formatting requirements? Please provide either a <u>file</u> or a <u>gifted copy</u> of your published e-book, book in true e-book form (including the cover art). e-books (including e-book files) are formatted and published to be read on dedicated e-reader devices or computer that feature a controllable viewing screen, or submit your entry by using a gifting process such as Amazon.

Are pen names allowed? Yes, you may enter under a pen name. Include your pen name on all forms as you would wish for them to appear in any credits. Please be advised (and advise us of it if you are notified as a winner) that we only need your legal name if you are chosen as a winner (in order to issue prizes).

#### What if I wanted to submit multiple titles (books), as a series?

Per our rules and guidelines, we can only accept a single book per submission (including books in a series). Because books are assigned to judges randomly, we are not able to guarantee that the same judge will be assigned all titles within the series. If you reach out to us by email on the same day that you submit your entries, we will certainly try our best to coordinate the same judge for all books in a series.

What if I would like to edit or exchange an entry that I have already submitted? Once an entry has been submitted, we do not accept edits, replacements or exchanges. If you wish to re-enter an edited piece, it is most acceptable and is considered as a new entry. You may wish to slightly alter the entry title or the file name in these cases, so that you are able to identify the versions-should you be selected as a winner.

Is there an age limit for entrants? All contest entrants must be aged 18 years or older or over the age of majority in the jurisdiction in which they reside.

How do I submit my entry fees? All entry fees are due in U.S. Dollars. Entry fees can be paid online by credit card/debit card (MC, V, AMEX & DISC) or PayPal.

Once the competition is over, will you return my entry? Entries are not returned.
