Policies and Procedures


Well-designed compliance programs include policies and procedures that give "content and effect to ethical norms and aim to reduce risks" identified through the risk assessment process.



Two Fundamental Requirements

A Code of Conduct that demonstrates full compliance with relevant Federal laws that is accessible and applicable to all company employees

Policies and Procedures that incorporate the culture of compliance into its day-to-day operations



The Starting Point: Code of Conduct

The foundation of a compliance program:

- Clear: Written for a basic audience. No legalese. Please.
- Concise: Short and sweet, preferably 5-10 pages, and make it interesting with pictures
- Accessible: Foreign languages, Intranet and Internet
- Make Code of Conduct and Policies part of Promotion of Company as an Ethical Company
- Maintain Regular Cadence for Code of Conduct Training and Review

Five Elements

- Design
- Comprehensiveness
- Accessibility
- Responsibility for Operational Integration
- Gatekeepers



Design and Comprehensiveness

- Design How does company design and implement new policies and procedures?
- What policies and procedures does company have in place?
- What is company's procedure for updating policies and procedures?
- Who is involved in the design and implementation of policies and procedures?
- What role does business play in this process?
- *Comprehensiveness* How does company monitor and implement policies and procedures and changes to legal and regulatory landscape?

Accessibility, Integration and Gatekeepers

Accessibility

- Communication of company policies and procedures
- Third-party awareness
- Foreign language accessibility
- Made available to employees (and third parties) in searchable format
- Tracking access to policies and procedures

Responsibility for Operational Integration

- Who is responsible for integrating into day-to-day operations?
- Widely-disseminated in easy format to ensure understanding and awareness
- Integrated into internal controls (beyond compliance controls)

Gatekeepers

- Approval responsibilities
- Training

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





Policies and procedures reflect your continuous risk updates

DOJ Evaluation Guidance Expectations

- Data-driven process
- Disfavor "snapshot" in time
- Favor "continuous" based on access to operational data and information across functions
- DOJ expects this information to be used to update other functions:
 - Risk assessments
 - Policies and procedures
 - Financial controls



DOJ Emphasis on Real-Time Monitoring and Continuous Improvement

Risk Assessment: "Why and how the company's compliance program has evolved over time."

Policies and Procedures: What is the company's process for "updating existing policies and procedures," and has "that process changed over time."

Third-Party Risks: "Does the company engage in risk management of third parties throughout the lifespan of the relationship, or primarily during the onboarding process?"


