

Pre-selected solar-panel installers competitively chosen by the community

Limited time campaigns to encourage participation

Since the last Solarize Program (2013)

- **Lower pricing:** cost of solar down 40% since 2013
- **Better technology:** more efficient, more choices, better warranties
- **New technology:** battery storage, EVSE, energy efficiency, and other
- **Incentives:** ITC phasing out; applies to battery storage
- **More financing options**





Sample Tiered Pricing Schedule


