Dr. Brenda Curtwright is a Florida certified educator and licensed speech-language pathologist and holds the national Certificate of Clinical Competence through the American Speech and Hearing Association. Dr. Curtwright has worked with children and adults in the area of social skill development for over 15 years.

Over the course of 7 lessons, participants will:

- Identify their personal strengths using self-reflection
- Practice **perspective-taking** appropriately as they give and receive feedback on their artwork
- Gain experience accepting constructive criticism and understanding differences

Workshop Description

Art lessons can elevate feelings of self-worth. It is an excellent opportunity for secondary-level students to learn about themselves and others. Group members will be instructed in art lessons using colored pencils, watercolors, and oil pastels. An art toolkit will be provided to group members. Research shows that classes taught online are as effective as in-person instruction.

Group Size

Brenda Curtwright and Associates specializes in small group size of 2 to 5 group members to increase engagement.

Cost

Services are paid on a self-pay basis. The cost is \$100/lesson, however, it is reduced to \$75/lesson if prepaid at the beginning of the month of July (\$525 for all seven lessons). A payment schedule will be given out at the beginning of each group's start day. **Note: Please be aware that fees will not be waived due to absences.** Methods of payment accepted: cash, check, and all major credit cards.
