

Common FAQs for online PTE preparation course

How long will I have access to the password once I receive my enrolment confirmation?

Access to your unique login and password is not time restricted, so you will have access until you have your first chance to login and update your password.

How long will I have access to the platform once I first login?

You will have unlimited access for 16 weeks (122 days) from the first access.

If I have problems logging in, who can I contact?

Will I get comments on my mistakes?

The software will show you the correct answers.

Will I have a CoE issued for the period that I am studying PTE if I package with another GWC course?

No, this course is a separate online course eligible to anyone around the world. There is no visa application attached to taking this course.

Do I need to take a test prior to the PTE course enrolment? Is there an entry requirement?

No, you do not need to take any other test prior to accessing the platform. There is no entry requirement, however, we recommend some familiarity with the English language - generally, we'd suggest CEFR B2/IELTS 5.5 or higher.

Will I have academic support through my training?

No, the platform is fully self-contained with 24/7 access. All parts are self-guided and paced without any human input.
