

REUSABLE PALLET WRAP - HOW TO APPLY IT

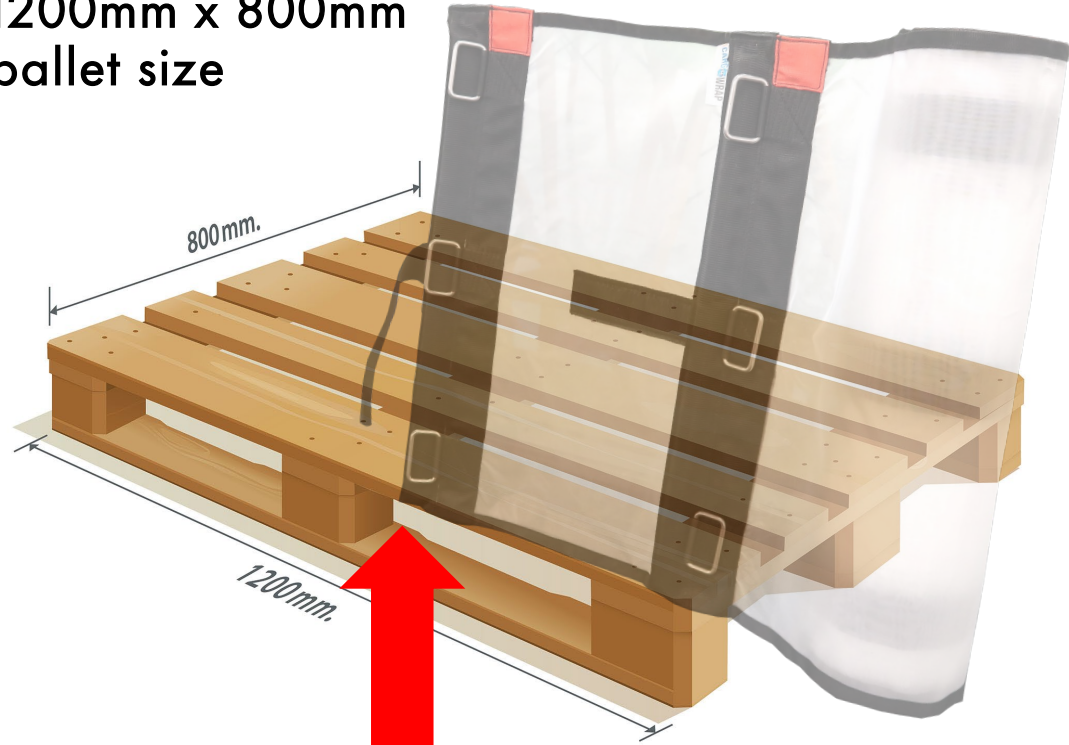


<p>STEP 1 The starting point is always on the longest edge of the pallet (PTO)</p>	<p>STEP 2 The CORNER STRAPS must be in this position (see arrow below)</p>	<p>STEP 3 Make sure the pallet wrap does not block forklift access to the pallet</p>	<p>STEP 4 Use the 2nd strap to secure the pallet wrap to the pallet.</p>
		<p>Keeping forking access clear</p>	
<p>STEP 5 Then secure the other three straps</p>	<p>STEP 6 The CORNER STRAPS are then unfolded and pulled under the pallet through to the other side of the corner, threaded through the buckle and pulled tight and secured</p>	<p>STEP 7 The top strap is passed over the pallet and secured at the other side</p>

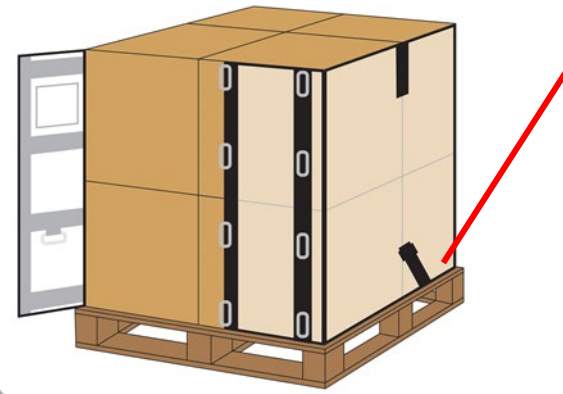
WHERE TO START THE WRAPPING PROCESS

When a reusable pallet-wrap has corner stability straps, these must be in the right place i.e. a corner of the pallet. This is the purpose of these instructions. If your reusable pallet-wrap does NOT have corner stability straps, then these instructions do not apply.

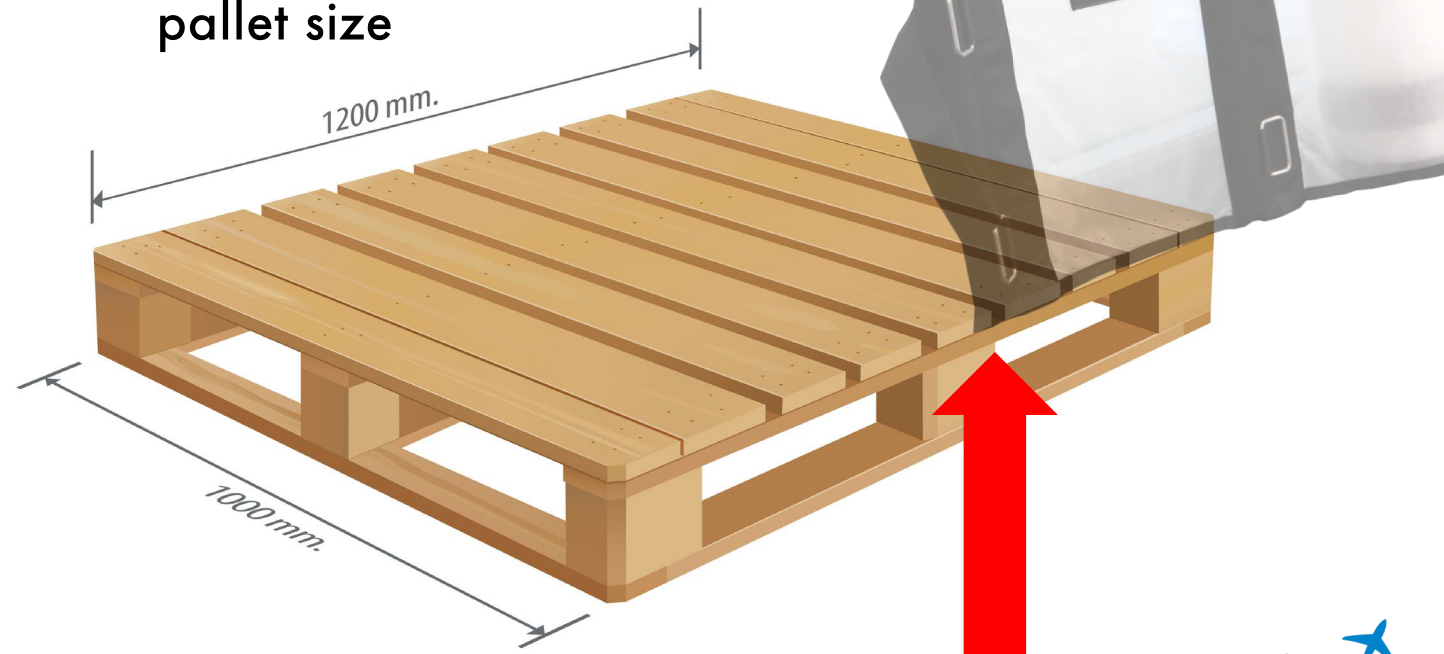
