

What issues are being addressed within the USASF? What is the process to determine which topics need attention? How are these issues prioritized? In our new infographic we explain how the decision making process works to respond to our members' needs.



Infographic: RAB & Regional Assembly Update

The process began in February with the selection of the Regional Advisory Boards (RAB). Coaches and owners were invited to apply for seats in their region and to provide three topics they feel are relevant to the success of the USASF. Once the RAB was selected, the recommended topics are reviewed and the top five issues were presented to the RAB to discuss at the annual meeting in June. Members of the Athlete Advisory Council were also invited to participate in these conversations. A poll was taken to establish priority.

At the National Meeting on July 25, 2021, feedback was gathered during the Regional, Dance and Athlete assemblies. The same topics were presented for discussion and suggestions were made for further action in the form of education, resources, initiatives or program development. USASF committees will be charged with exploring these suggestions to determine alignment with the USASF mission as well as consider cost effectiveness and budgetary concerns. Not every suggestion will automatically move forward. After review, recommendations may be made to: dismiss as outside of the scope of the USASF mission; return to membership for further support; assign a task force to develop more tangible goals; or reprioritize and defer. Recommendations that move forward will be reviewed by the appropriate committee and if approved, will be moved to the Board of Directors for further review and approval.

Regional Advisory Board & Regional Assembly Update

The Regional Advisory Board met in June 2021 to discuss and prioritize issues relevant to the success of the USASF. Members of the Athlete Advisory Council also were invited to participate in these conversations. Suggestions were made for further action in the form of education, resources, initiatives or program development. 
