Key Responsibilities and Duties:

- Implement analytical methods using R or other specialist analytical software under the direction and supervision of senior analytical colleagues.
- Design and produce high quality analytical outputs including charts, maps, and tables.
- Research and locate relevant data and information sources
- Assist with the delivery of workshops
- Assist with the delivery of presentations of analytical results to clients
- Participate in a range of training and development opportunities to develop their analytical skills and competencies.
