PHARMACY ALERT

We have been notified by the pharmacy that residents MUST bring the following when arriving for their vaccine:

- Identification (Driver's License, State ID)
- Medicare Card
- Supplemental Insurance Card

Residents receiving their first dose need to arrive in the Ringling Room at 8:45 am on Wednesday, January 13, 2021.

On Wednesday, January 13, 2021, you will receive your first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, administered by Walgreens Pharmacy. *The vaccine clinic will be held in the Ringling Room.*

Due to the number of people that signed up for the vaccine, we will be unable to adjust the schedule. Please arrive on time and not early as we will be unable to accommodate those who arrive before their designated time slot.

Important details:

- ✓ Please arrive at your designated time (schedule on reverse).
- ✓ You must bring your Identification and your Insurance Card(s).
- ✓ Please wear a short-sleeved shirt to make the injection site visible (please bring a cardigan sweater if needed for comfort).
- ✓ Make sure you are wearing a mask and adhere to social distancing.
- ✓ You will be asked the following 5 questions. *BE PREPARED TO PROVIDE ANSWERS*:
 - 1. Do you feel sick today?
 - 2. Do you have any health condition, such as heart disease, diabetes or asthma?
 - 3. Do you have allergies to latex, medications, food or vaccines (examples: eggs, bovine protein, gelatin, gentamicin (this is an antibiotic) polymyxin (this is an antibiotic) neomycin (antibiotic) phenol, yeast or thimerosal (vaccine additive/preservative).
 - 4. Have you ever had a reaction after receiving a vaccination, including fainting or feeling dizzy?
 - 5. Have you ever had a seizure disorder for which you are on seizure medication(s), a brain disorder, Guillian-Barre syndrome (a condition that cause paralysis) or other nervous system disorder?
 - 6. Have you had a vaccine/injection within the last 14 days?

Bring a list of answers with you if it helps you to remember! We will be moving quickly to get everyone completed in an efficient and timely manner.

IMPORTANT NOTE: After you receive your vaccine, you MUST wait at least 15 minutes, under the observation of a nurse before you are permitted to exit.

This 'observation holding area' will be in the Bay Club Lounge. You will proceed there immediately after your vaccination.

NOTE:

Your second dose will be administered on Wednesday, February 3, 2021. You will receive a 'Save the Date' card on January 13, 2021.
