

OFFICIAL TERMS

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. Please read our Official Terms in their entirety before submitting an Application for the RX1 Bioprinter Grant Program (“Program”). Submission of an Application to this program constitutes your acceptance of these Official Rules and that you satisfy all eligibility requirements. Void where restricted or prohibited by law.

1. SPONSOR

The Program is sponsored by Aspect Biosystems Ltd., 1781 West 75th Avenue, Vancouver BC, Canada V6P 6P2 (“Sponsor”).

2. BINDING AGREEMENT

Each entity submitting or attempting to submit an entry (“Applicant” or “you”) for the “RX1 Bioprinter Grant Program” agrees to be bound by these Official Terms (“Terms”) and the decisions of the Sponsor, which are final and binding. Therefore, please read these Rules prior to entry to ensure you understand and agree. The Program is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Winning the Award is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein.

Participation constitutes Applicant’s full and unconditional agreement to these Rules and Sponsor’s decisions, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Program. You may not submit an entry to the Program and are not eligible to receive the Award described in these Rules unless you agree to these Rules. Any and all individuals submitting an entry on behalf of an entity represents that such individual is acting within the scope of his/her employment, as an employee, contractor, or agent of such entity. Such individual warrants that (a) such entity has full knowledge of his/her actions and has consented thereto and (b) his/her actions do not violate the entity’s policies and procedures.

3. AWARD DESCRIPTION:

Two winners will be selected to receive the following:

- RX1™ bioprinter for six months, including shipping
- Starter Kit (3x printheads, biomaterials, crosslinker, buffer)
- Virtual instruction and training

4. PROGRAM PERIOD:

All entries must be submitted on or before the submission deadline.

5. ELIGIBILITY:

- Applicant must be conducting research at a university or non-profit research institute for the duration of the project.
- Applications that propose clinical trial uses, or any use in humans, are excluded from this Program and will not be considered.

6. HOW TO APPLY:

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.

To apply, Applicants should go to the Program web page at <https://info.aspectbiosystems.com/rx1-bioprinter-grant-program> to download the Application Form (“Application”). The following information is requested on the Application:

1. A description of your current research focus
2. A six-month project plan with milestones
3. Summary of resources available to support this project (i.e. consumable purchases, researchers(s) involved in the project).
4. Description of how bioprinting will be incorporated into your long-term research

All Applications must be submitted on the Program web page on or before submission deadline. Sponsor will consider multiple entries per participant and organization. Entries become the sole property of Sponsor and should not include confidential information. In the event the Applicant wishes to submit confidential information, a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) can be signed. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any Application not in compliance with these Rules.

7. SELECTION PROCESS:

The Program Selection Committee, a select group of employees of the Sponsor, will determine the Winner(s) based on the following criteria:

- (i) **Scientific merit:** Quality of research objectives and experimental design
- (ii) **“Cool factor”:** Novelty of the research plan
- (iii) **Feasibility:** Reasonable ability to achieve the research objectives

The decision is in the sole discretion of the Program Selection Committee, will be final, and cannot be appealed.

8. AWARD NOTIFICATION:

The selected Winner(s) will be notified by email using the contact information provided in the Application. If the Winner (i) cannot be contacted; (ii) fails to respond to multiple attempts of notification; (iii) fails to produce proof attesting that the information provided in the application form is accurate; (iv) refuses the Award; or (v) fails to accept the terms and conditions of the Sponsor’s Technology Access Agreement, then the winning Applicant is disqualified and forfeits all rights to the Award and the Sponsor reserves the right to choose an alternate Winner. Confirmation of the award is contingent on the Applicant’s institution accepting the terms and conditions of the Sponsor’s Technology Access Agreement.

9. GENERAL RULES:

- By submitting an Application, an Applicant acknowledges that the Applicant has the requisite resources for the duration of the 6-month program.
- No financial or other compensation will be awarded.
- Submission of an Application constitutes Applicant’s full and unconditional acknowledgement and agreement that (i) all Applications and all parts of the application become the property of the Sponsor and will not be returned to Applicant; (ii) the Application shall not include any confidential or trade secret information of the Applicant or Applicant’s employer, unless an NDA is signed before submission, (iii) the Sponsor will have no liability or obligations of confidentiality and non-use of any information submitted in or accompanying the complete application form.
- In the event of a dispute regarding an Application, the Application will be deemed to have been submitted by the authorized account holder of the email address used for submission. The authorized account holder (i) is defined as the Applicant; (ii) must comply with the Official Terms; and (iii) may be required to provide proof, to the Sponsor’s satisfaction, that he/or she is the authorized account holder.
- By submitting an Application, Applicant gives the Sponsor permission to contact Applicant about products and services, whether or not Applicant’s Application is chosen as a Winner.

- The Award is not transferable: no substitutions or cash equivalents will be provided.
- Failure by the Sponsor to enforce any terms or provision of these Rules shall not constitute a waiver of the term or provision or any other term.
- The Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend this program without notice.
- The Winner of the program agrees to share data and/or results with the Sponsor, on a confidential basis, from the research described in the Application.
- For the Winner of the program: by accepting the Award, the Applicant is subject to the terms and conditions of the Sponsor's Technology Access Agreement.
- For the Winner of the program: by accepting the Award, the Applicant grants the Sponsor permission to use (for marketing purposes) the Applicant's name, biographical information, likeness, without further compensation, except where prohibited by law and as otherwise provided herein.
- Application Forms must be original to the Applicant and must not infringe any third-party proprietary rights, intellectual property rights, industrial property rights, personal or moral rights or any other rights, including without limitation, copyright, trademark, patent, trade secret or confidentiality obligations, or otherwise violate applicable laws. No trademarks, logos, company names or advertising of third parties are allowed unless expressly permitted by Sponsor. Content may not be offensive or defamatory, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject and/ or disqualify any entries (in whole or in part) that Sponsor deems, in its sole discretion, to be threatening, abusive, harassing, offensive, obscene, defamatory, libelous, hateful, embarrassing to another person or entity, profane, discriminatory, false, misleading or deceptive, invasive of another's privacy, tortious, or that promote illegal behavior, or otherwise are inconsistent with its editorial standards or reputational interests, or that Sponsor believes may violate any applicable law or regulation, these Rules, or the rights of any third party.

10. CHOICE OF LAW AND VENUE:

By submitting an Application, each Applicant agrees that all issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation or enforceability of these Terms, the Applicant's right and obligations under the Program and the Sponsor's rights and obligations under the Program shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the province of British Columbia, Canada. By submitting an Application, each Applicant consents to the jurisdiction of the provincial court of British Columbia, Canada.
