
Drastic drops in Halloween activities anticipated for 2020


For those planning to hand out candy, most will do so at their door, utilizing many protective measures believed to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

% of Total Respondents




Spending Compared to Last Year % of Those Who Bought in 2019 or Will/May Buy in 2020



2019 vs. 2020 Halloween Celebrations % of Total Respondents


