This week's insights were collected Friday, September 4 – Monday, September 7 among a general population of n=300 U.S. consumers age 21+.


#### Summer travel took a hit during the COVID-19 pandemic.

While summer stays with friends and family were down, this may pick up before end of year - just in time for the holidays.


# 2020 Summer Travel (June-August)

% of Total Respondents




### **Attitudes in Light of COVID-19**
